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Be it remembered that heretofore, to wit: on the 14th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty five, the Council of the village of New Bremen in the County of Auglaize and State of Ohio, passed an ordinance in words and figures following to wit:

Ordinance.

August 14, 1865. The Council of the village of New Bremen met, present, a full board. On motion of William Buss it was unanimously resolved that the territory known as Vogelsangtown and the lots west of the Miami canal and between Vogelsangtown shall be annexed to the town of New Bremen.

Notice: Afterwards a notice was published of which the following is a true copy:
Notice is hereby given that at the December Session 1865 of the Board of Commissioners of Anglin County a petition was presented to them by the Council of the incorporated village of New Bremen in said county praying that the territory adjoining said village known as Vogelsangtown and other Out Lots be annexed to said village and that at the March session of said Commissioners at the Office of the Auditor of Anglin County said petition will be for hearing.

Afterward December - 1865 the following proceedings were had by the Commissioners of Anglin County. Ord.

Order: The petition of the council of the incorporated village of New Bremen was this day presented to the Commissioners praying for the annexation of the territory known as Vogelsangtown to said village of New Bremen. Whereupon it is ordered that said petition

and all papers appertaining thereto be filed with the Auditor and that the petitioners proceed to publish notice of the filing of said petition in the manner prescribed by law. And it is further ordered that said petition be heard at the next regular meeting of the Commissioners.

Said petition was in words and figures following, to wit:

To the Honorable, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Auglaize State of Ohio; Your petitioners, the council of the incorporated village of New Bremen in said county respectfully represent that on the 14th day of August AD 1865, they passed an ordinance for the annexation of certain territory adjoining said village known as Vogelsangtown and other territory particularly described in a plat filed herewith. They further represent that pursuant to notice duly given an election was held on the 28th day of August 1865 by the qualified electors of said village of New Bremen to determine whether said territory shall be annexed or not and that a large majority of said electors voted for annexation, as will appear by a certified copy of the poll book filed herewith. Your petitioners further represent that they have in all respects complied with the statute in such case made and provided and pray that said territory may be ordered to be annexed to said village &c. Sept. 20th 1865.

Afterwards at the March session AD 1866 the following proceedings were had, viz: In the matter of the petition of the Council of the village of New Bremen for the annexation of territory to said village.

This day came the petitioners and having proved that notice of the filing and pending of said petition has been given in the manner prescribed by law and having satisfied the Board of Commissioners have in all things complied with the required section of the Statutes in such case made and provided, and no remonstrance or other measure adverse to the prayer of said petition having been taken. It is ordered by the board, that the prayer of said petition be granted, and that the territory described in the plat filed herein as the Vogelsangtown and the other lots in said plat described be and the same is hereby annexed to the said village of New Bremen. And it is further ordered that the Auditor endorse this entry on the petition aforesaid and deliver to the Recorder of this county the said petition with the endorsement aforesaid and the plat filed herewith with all papers and proceedings filed herein to be by said Recorder recorded in the records of this county according to the Statutes in such case made and provided. And it is further ordered that the petitioners do within 30 days pay the costs of these proceedings.
