SW Corner $\frac{23}{50}$

This map represents Wm L. F. Koops subdivision situated and described as follows: The south west part of the south east quarter of Section number fifteen (15), Town number seven (7) south, Range number four (4) east, and commencing at the South West corner of said quarter section running north with twenty six (26) chains and thirteen (13) links; thence east with twenty one (21) chains and fifty (50) links to the center of the Canal; thence south along the center of the Canal to the south section line; thence west with twenty three chains and fifty links to the place of beginning containing sixty one (61) acres more or less.

Said fraction is divided into twelve (12) lots, each lot is containing five (5) acres, except Lot number twelve (12) which is containing six (6) acres more or less. All these lots are running from west to east and the width and number are given on plat. The distance are given in chains and links, and one quarter of an inch is one chain.
