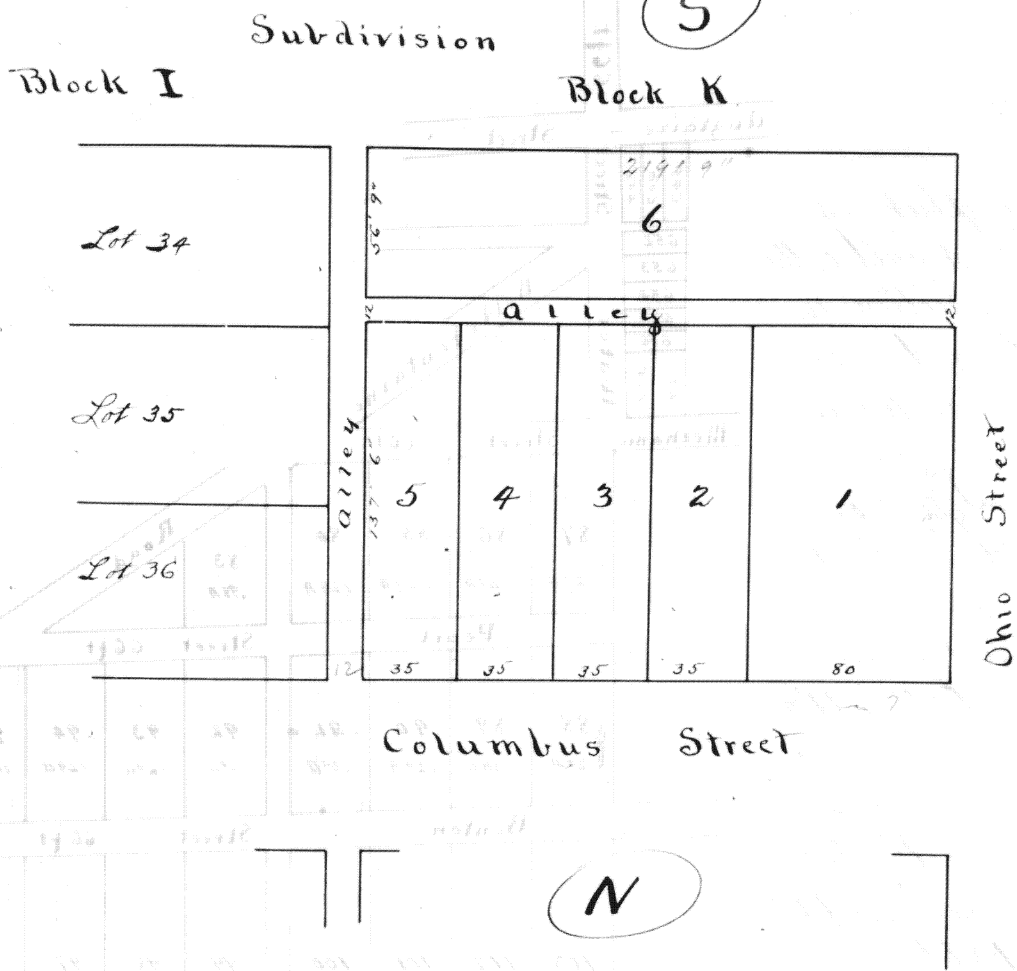


Subdivision Block K, Minster, Ohio.



Block "K" of Lots number thirty four (34) thirty five (35) and thirty six (36), in the village of Minster, County of Auglaize and State of Ohio, are laid off and subdivided as follows: Lot number one (1) commences on the corner of Columbus and Ohio Streets, running and fronting on said Columbus street eighty (80) feet more or less with a depth running south one hundred and thirty seven feet and six inches (137' 6") to an alley twelve (12) feet wide running east and west. Lots numbers 2, 3, 4 and 5, (two, three, four and five) each and every one fronting on Columbus street thirty five (35) feet with the same depth as Lot No. One, one hundred and thirty seven feet and six inches (137' 6") to the same alley. Lot number six (6) is fronting fifty six (56) feet and nine (9) inches on Ohio Street, running in depth east to the alley two hundred and nineteen feet and nine inches more or less, and the alley laid off is twelve feet wide and running the same depth on the north line of said lot number six (6) to intersect with an alley running north and south, said alley is laid out between the south line of Lots number one, two, three, four and five and the north line of lot number six.

Said lots are subdivided by Henry Busse the present proprietor of said lots to which the acknowledgment is attached.

In Witness Whereof the said Henry Busse and Mary Busse his wife who hereby release all her right and expectancy of dower in said premises, granted for an alley, have hereunto set their hands and seals this sixteenth day of February A.D. 1867.
