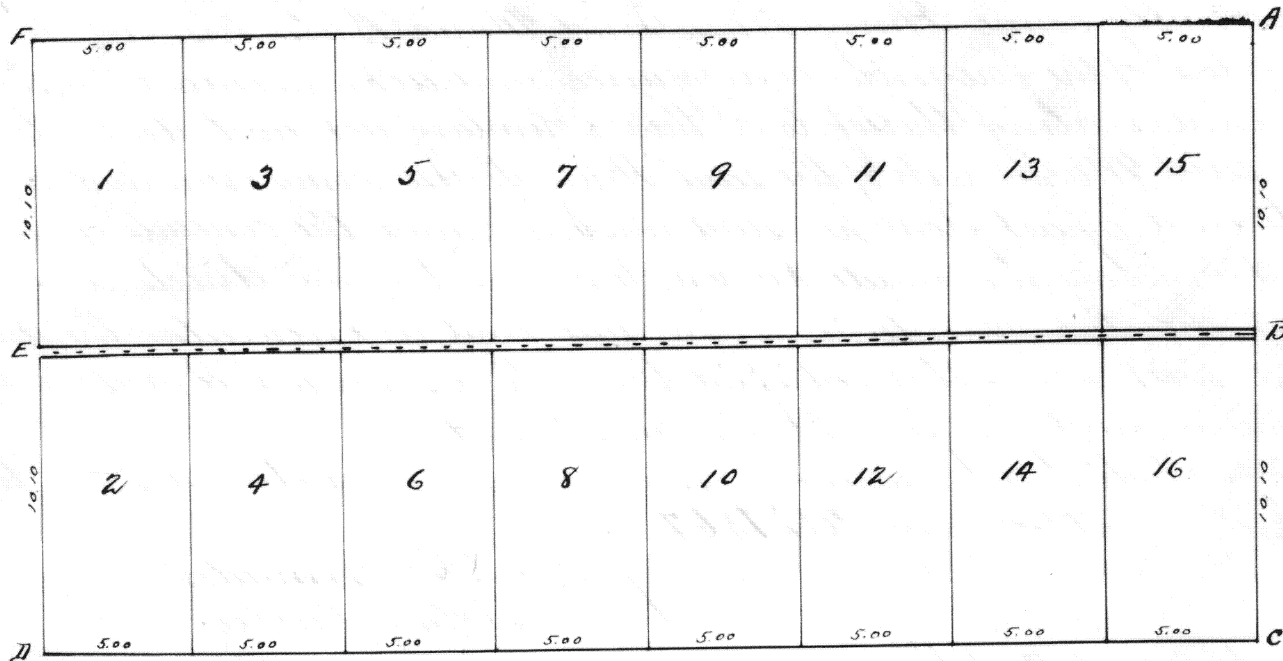




Plat and field notes of the North half of the North East quarter of Section No. 35, Town 7 south, Range 4 east as subdivided by William Menke in Auglaize County, Ohio. Surveyed April 3d. 1867. See above plat.

Remarks to the above plat.

The corner marked "A" is the north east corner of Section number 35, town 7 south, range 4 east.

Lines.

A. C. is the east line of Wm. Menke's subdivision, Dist. 20.20 chains.

C. D. is the south line of said Addition, Dist. 40.00 chains.

D. F. is the west line of the subdivision also the east line of the old plat of the town of Minister, Distance 20.20 chains.

F. A. is the north line of said subdivision and runs through the center of a county road, Distance 40.00 chains. A. E. runs east and west through the center of an alley which is 20 feet wide.

Lots are all of the same size 10.10 chains by 5.00 chains.
