David Seltzer's Addition of In Lots to Wapakoneta, Ohio.

At the request of David Seltzer of Wapakoneta, Ohio, I proceeded on the 18th day of April A.D. 1869 to survey the In Lots represented on the accompanying Plat. The tract of land upon which said lots are laid off is described as follows: being Out Lot forty five (45) and a part of Out Lot number forty six (46), the same lying east and adjoining G.W. Andrews &c Co. Addition of In Lots and lying between Mechanics and Benton streets in the town of Wapakoneta, Auglaize County, Ohio. Pearl Street is sixty six (66) feet wide, Seltzer Street fifty (50) feet. The two alleys east and west are one (1) rod wide; the alley north and south is sixteen (16) feet wide. The lots are all fifty by one hundred and fifty feet, except 711-698-697+684 which are of the width marked upon the plat, viz: 711-64 ft. 11 in. on south and 65 ft. 2 in. on north end; 698 is 65 ft. 6 in. on north end; No. 697 is 65 ft. 7 in. on south end. No. 684 is 66 ft. 4 in. on north end. Stones are planted at the N.E. corner of lot No. 690 and the South east corner of Lot No. 705. The ground lying east of the In Lots or between the lots and the land line and marked on the plat as 48 ft. 8 in. in width on the South end and 19 ft. 3 in. on the north. Said strip of ground is withheld from street purposes until the balance of Water Street (between said lots Out Lots 87+88) is opened.
