


J.W. & Ellen Elliott's In Lots to Wapakoneta, O.



The above plat represents a survey of the lots made by me for John W. Elliott and Ellen Elliott of the town of Wapakoneta, Auglaize County, Ohio, on the 22d day of June 1870. The lots are laid off on the east part of Land Fraction No. 5 in Section No. 29, Town five (5) south, Range six (6) east. The west line of said John W. Elliott's tract of ground is represented by the dotted line it being the west line of lot No. 285, said town continued north to the Auglaize river. Mrs. Ellen Elliott's ground lies west of and adjoining said tract of John W. Elliott's. The lots are all fifty (50) by one hundred and fifty (150) feet except lot No. 791 which is 70 feet wide on the north end. The three alleys north and south are one rod wide. The back alley is 20 feet wide. Place of beginning is two hundred and eighteen (218) feet from the south west corner of lot No. 439 measured on Auglaize street to south west corner of W. W. M. Elliott's lot. I hereby certify the above to be a correct map of the survey made by me June 22^d 1870.
