



The above plat represents G. W. Holbrook's Second South Addition of In Lots to the Town of Wapakoneta, Auglaize County, Ohio, being a subdivision of In Lots No. 778, 779, 780 and 781 laid off by George W. Holbrook in October 1869. The Survey of the above described Addition commences at a point sixty six feet west of (on side of Race street) in In Lot No. 757 of said town. The alleys are each one rod in width. Plum Street is sixty feet in width. South street is 50 feet in width, on the west side Street (Ohio) is allowed 33 feet. The lots are each 50 by 150 feet and numbered from 796 to 819 inclusive.
