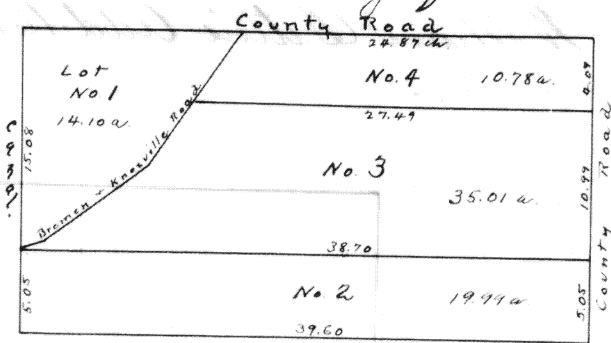


Section No. Two (2). Town No. Seven (7), Range four (4).



This plat represents the North half of the South East quarter of Section number two (2) of Town No. seven (7) south, Range No. four (4) east containing seventy nine $\frac{7}{100}$ acres. The object thereof is to show how said land is subdivided in small parcels of land which are numbered and described as follows:

Lot No. 1 - Commencing 24.78 chains west from the N.E. corner of said quarter section, running west 14.93 chains to the center of Canal, thence South along the center of canal 15.08 chains to the center of bridge crossing canal, thence in a north easterly direction along the center of New Bremen + Knoxville road to the place of beginning, containing 14 $\frac{10}{100}$ acres of land.

Lot No. 2 - Commencing 15.08 chains south of the North East corner of said quarter section, running South 5.05 chains, thence east 39.60 chains to the center of said canal, thence North to the center of bridge crossing canal 5.05 chains, thence east 39.60 chains to the place of beginning containing 19 $\frac{97}{100}$ acres.

Lot No. 3 - Commencing 4.09 chains south of the N.E. corner of said quarter section, running South 10.49 chains, thence west 38.70 chains to the center of the New Bremen and Knoxville road, thence in a north easterly direction along the center of said road 16.25 chains, thence east 27.49 chains to the place of beginning, containing 35 $\frac{01}{100}$ acres of land.

Lot No. 4 - Commencing on the North east corner of said quarter section, running South 4.09 chains, thence west 27.49 chains to the center of the New Bremen + Knoxville road, thence along the center of said road in a North Easterly direction to the quarter section line 5.10 chains, thence east 24.87 chains to the place of beginning, containing 10 $\frac{78}{100}$ acres.
