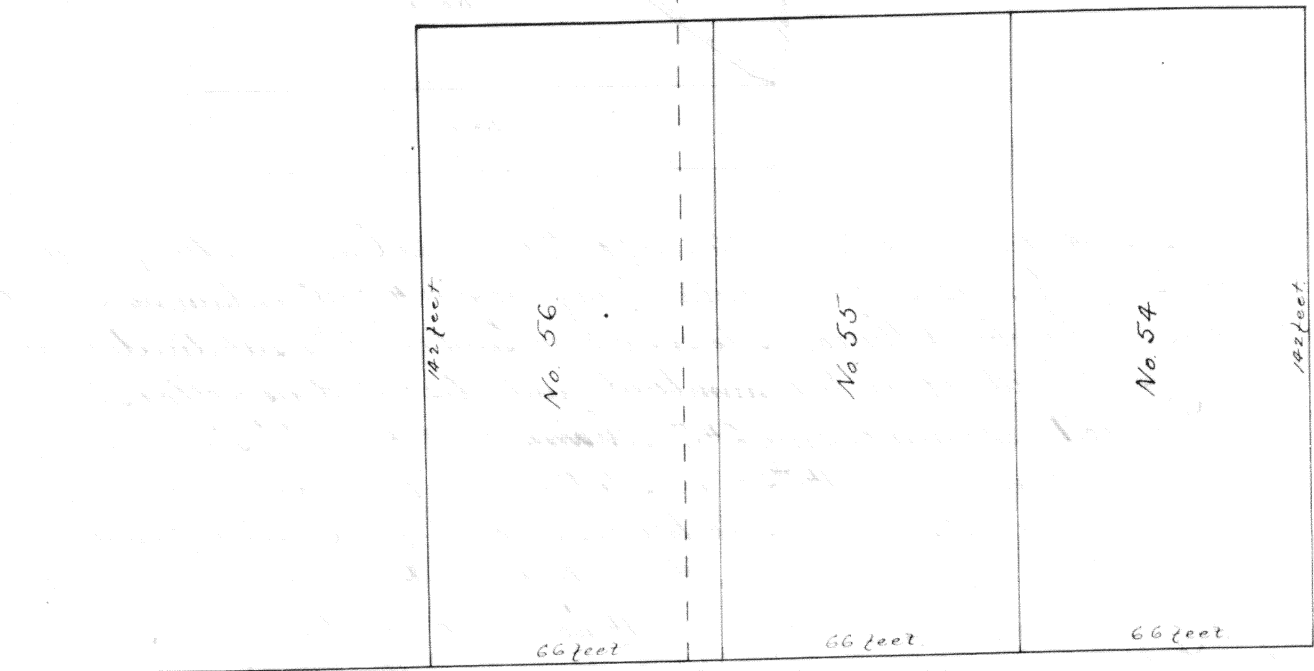

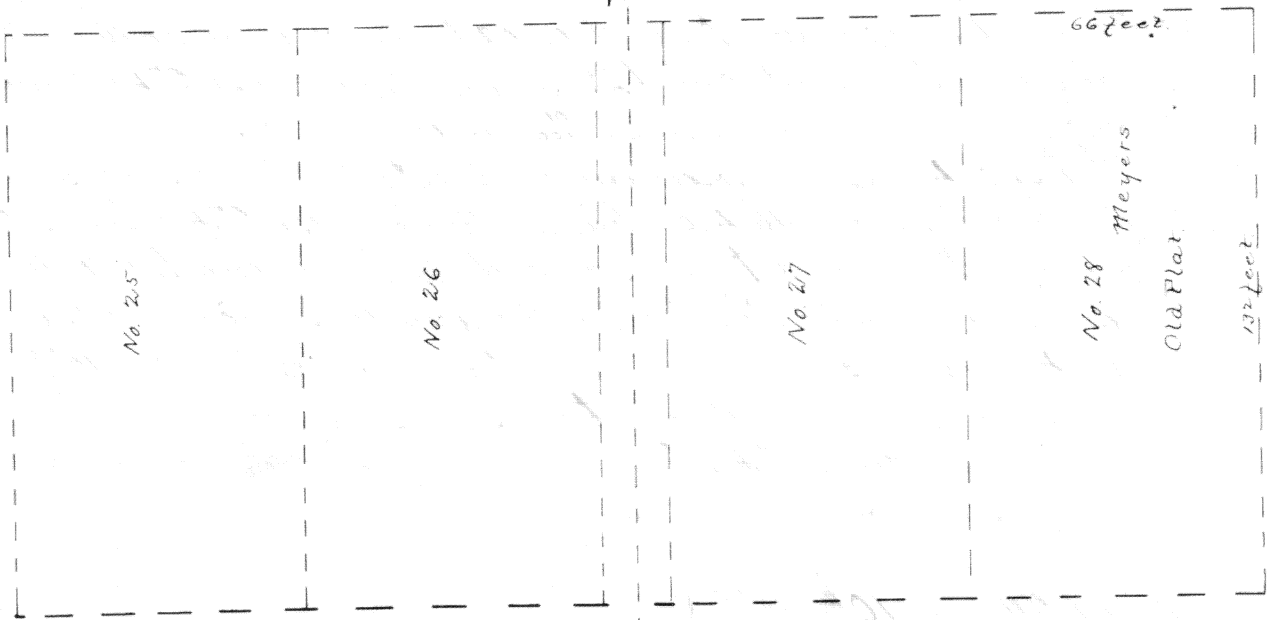

The plat hereon shown represents an Addition of Sw Lots to the town of St. Johns, Auglaize County, Ohio, laid off by Wm. Bitter and by me surveyed on the 19th day of January A.D. 1872. Lots are numbered 54, 55, + 56 and are four rods front to west by eight rods and ten feet back, laid off on N.E. corner of W $\frac{1}{2}$ of N.W $\frac{1}{4}$ Section number 5, Town 6, Range 7 east and the South Part of East half of S.W $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section number 32, Town 5 South, Range 7 east.

The above plat also represents the connection of the three lots numbers 54, 55 + 56 so laid off as aforesaid, with the old plat of St. Johns. The place of beginning being sixty six feet east of the South East corner of Lot No. twenty eight of old plat (Original).

I certify the above to be a true representation of Wm. Bitter's Addition to said town.
