


Map "A"



Incorporation of New Knoxville, O } To the Hon Board of Commissioners of Auglaize County and State of Ohio. - Your petitioners respectfully represent that they are inhabitants of said county residing on and adjacent to the territory laid off into village lots a plat of which has been made and recorded, situated in said county of Auglaize and State of Ohio, to wit: Section number nineteen (19), twenty (20), twenty nine (29) and thirty (30) all in Washington township, and township six (6) south, Range five (5) east: that the supposed number of inhabitants is about three hundred and five (305); that they desire said territory to be organized into an incorporated village for special purposes by the name New Knoxville. The following named persons residing on said territory are hereby authorized to act as agents in behalf of your petitioners in the premises, to wit: Wm Kuck, Drv. Wm. Feuermann, and W.H. Deneckamp. An accurate map of the territory above described is hereto attached marked "A" and made a part of this petition.

Your petitioners therefore pray that your Honorable Body will take such action in the premises as may be necessary for the purpose of organizing the territory above described into an incorporated village for special purposes, as your petitioners will ever pray.

In the matter of the petition
for the incorporation of the town
of New Knoxville, Auglaize Co. O

Monday, June 1st, 1874.

This day came H.H. Duthikamp et al.
and presented to the Board a petition pray-

ing for the incorporation of New Knoxville,

in said county, which was duly received and ordered to be filed in the
Auditors office of said county of Auglaize there to be kept subject to the
inspection of any person or persons interested. And it was further or-
dered that Wm. Kuck, Wm. Fennemann and H.H. Duthikamp, the
agents of said petitioners give notice containing the substance of said
petition in accordance with the statute in such case made and pro-
vided and the said petition and application will be heard at the Audi-
tors office in said county of Auglaize on the 3d. day of August AD 1874 to
which time the matter is adjourned.

Monday, August 3d 1874. The Board met pursuant to adjournment.
In the matter of the application for the incorporation of New Knoxville, Ohio:

This day said petition came on to be further heard pursuant to the
order of this board heretofore made in the premises, and upon examina-
tion and consideration of said petition we do find that it contains all
the matters required by law and that all the statements therein made
are true: that the name proposed for such corporation, to wit: New Knox-
ville is appropriate; that the limits thereof have been accurately described
and that the same are not unreasonably large or small and that the map
or plat thereof is correctly made; that the persons whose names are sub-
scribed thereto are legal voters residing on said territory; that notice of
the time and place of hearing hereof has been given by said agents as
heretofore ordered by this Board, and that more than fifty qualified
voters reside on said territory. It is therefore ordered that said peti-
tion be granted and that said territory be organized as an incorporated
village for special purposes and that the same be named and known
as New Knoxville, and it is further ordered that the Auditor of this
county make out a full and complete certified transcript of all
the proceedings and orders of this Board herein and after the
same shall be signed by us he cause it to be delivered together
with the petition and map accompanying said petition and
all the other papers on file in his office to the Recorder of this

county to be by him placed on file in his office in pursuance of law.
