

St. Johns.

Ordinance No. 4.

Whereas on the 15th. day of June AD 1877 a majority of the qualified voters of the incorporated village of St. Johns, Adams County, Ohio, at a special election held for that purpose, voted for a surrender of the corporate rights and franchises of said village. Therefore

Resolved by the Trustees of said village for special purposes, that said rights and franchises are hereby surrendered and said village of St. Johns is hereby restored and reinstated in all the rights and privileges held by the same prior to the incorporation thereof.

Done this 22^d day of June AD 1877.
