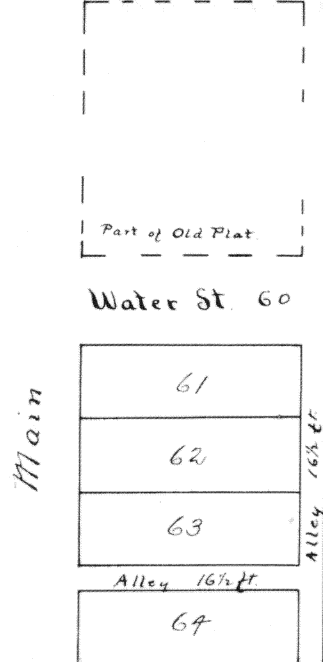
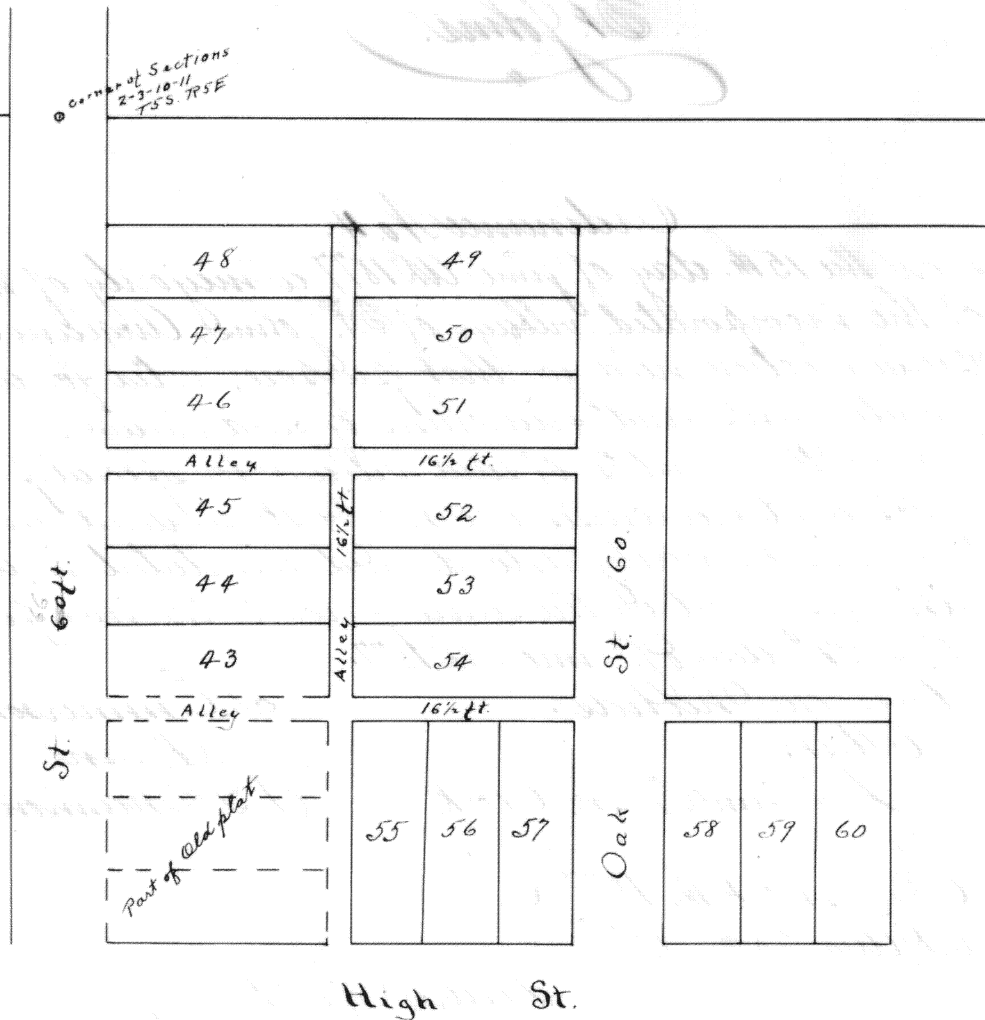




John N. Gochunow's 2^d Addition

Know all men by these presents: that I John H. Gochenour of Auglaize County, Ohio, do make public and adopt the annexed plat of the Second Addition to the town of Whitefeather, Auglaize County, Ohio, as laid out by Samuel Craig, Surveyor, in the West fraction of the North West Quarter of Section eleven, town five south, range five east, of which I am proprietor, and dedicate to the use of the public forever as highways the streets and alleys therein indicated and named.
