



These two plats represent Block No. 25¹⁵ of the East Addition and the Fraction No. 19, all of the town of St. Marys, Auglaize County, Ohio. The object thereof is to show that Plat No. 1 represents the tract of land above mentioned, and the Plat No. 2 represents the tracts of land after alteration by putting both tracts of land into one body and then subdividing this tract again into Dw Lots. The size and distances of Dw Lots and Alley are given on plat, also the number of Lots. Scale 3/8 inch to 25 feet. I certify this is a true and correct survey done this 2d day of March 1881, by Wm. Limbacher Civil Engt.

The above alteration was ordered by the undersigned and a petition to the council of the above mentioned town for a permission to make said alteration was granted on the 5th day of April 1881.
