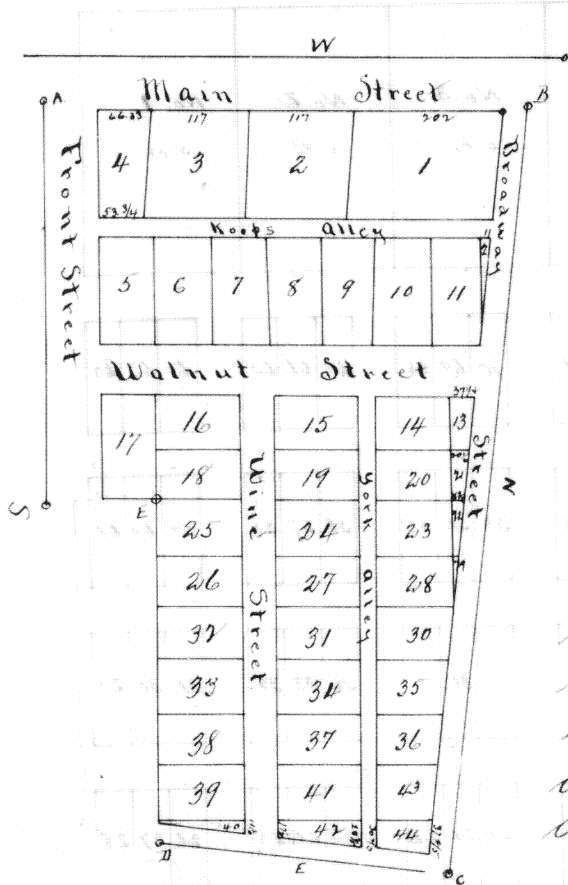


William and Benjamin Koop and John Boshe

Before me Wm. Finke a Justice of the Peace in and for said county personally appeared William and Benjamin Koop and John F. Boshe and acknowledged the signing and sealing of the within East Addition of Bremen to be their voluntary act and deed, this 22^d day of June AD 1848.

Plat of William and Benjamin Koop and John F. Boshe's town lots of the East Addition to Bremen, and laid out on the East half of the North East quarter of Section 15, Township 7 south of range 4 east in the County of Auglaize, Ohio. North and south streets are 10 degrees west of magnetic right angles. Front and Walnut streets are 66 feet wide. Main street is 45 feet wide. The alleys are 16 1/2 feet wide. 20 feet is given to each section line on the north and east side. Lot No. 1-202 by 132, 2-3-117 by 132, 4-66 3/5 by 132 feet. Lots Nos. 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 + 17 are 66 feet wide and 132 feet long. Lot No. 12-115, 13-27 1/5, 21-20 1/6, 22-12 1/5, 29-5 3/4, 40-11 1/10, 42-28 3/5, 44-37 1/5 feet wide. All other lots are 66 feet wide and 99 feet long. Stones are planted on the corners A, B, C, D, E, F.

Commencing with letter A on the south west corner of said addition; thence north to D; thence east to C; thence south to D; thence west to E; thence south to F; thence west letter A again.
