

Renumbering of Out Lots
St. Marys.

In pursuance of an Act entitled "An act authorizing the numbering of Lots in any city, town or borough in this state to be revised", passed February 2^d 1848, The Auditor and Recorder in conjunction with R. Patton appointed by the Council of St. Marys, met in the Auditor's office of said county on the 28th day of May A.D. 1880 and proceeded to revise the numbers of all the Out Lots of said town so as to have but one consecutive series of numbers of Out Lots, as follows, to wit:
