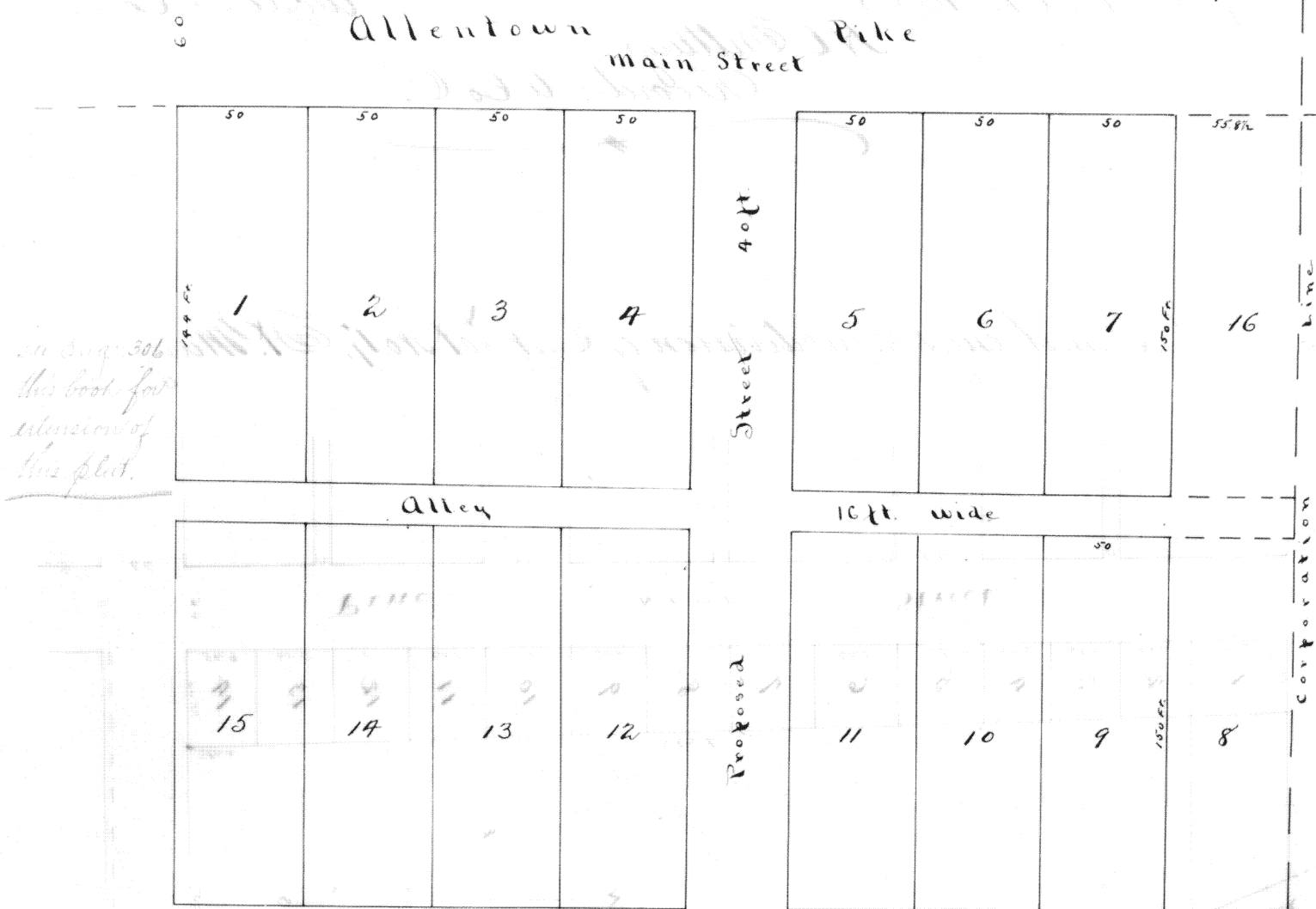


*Plat of Joseph Baker's Lots

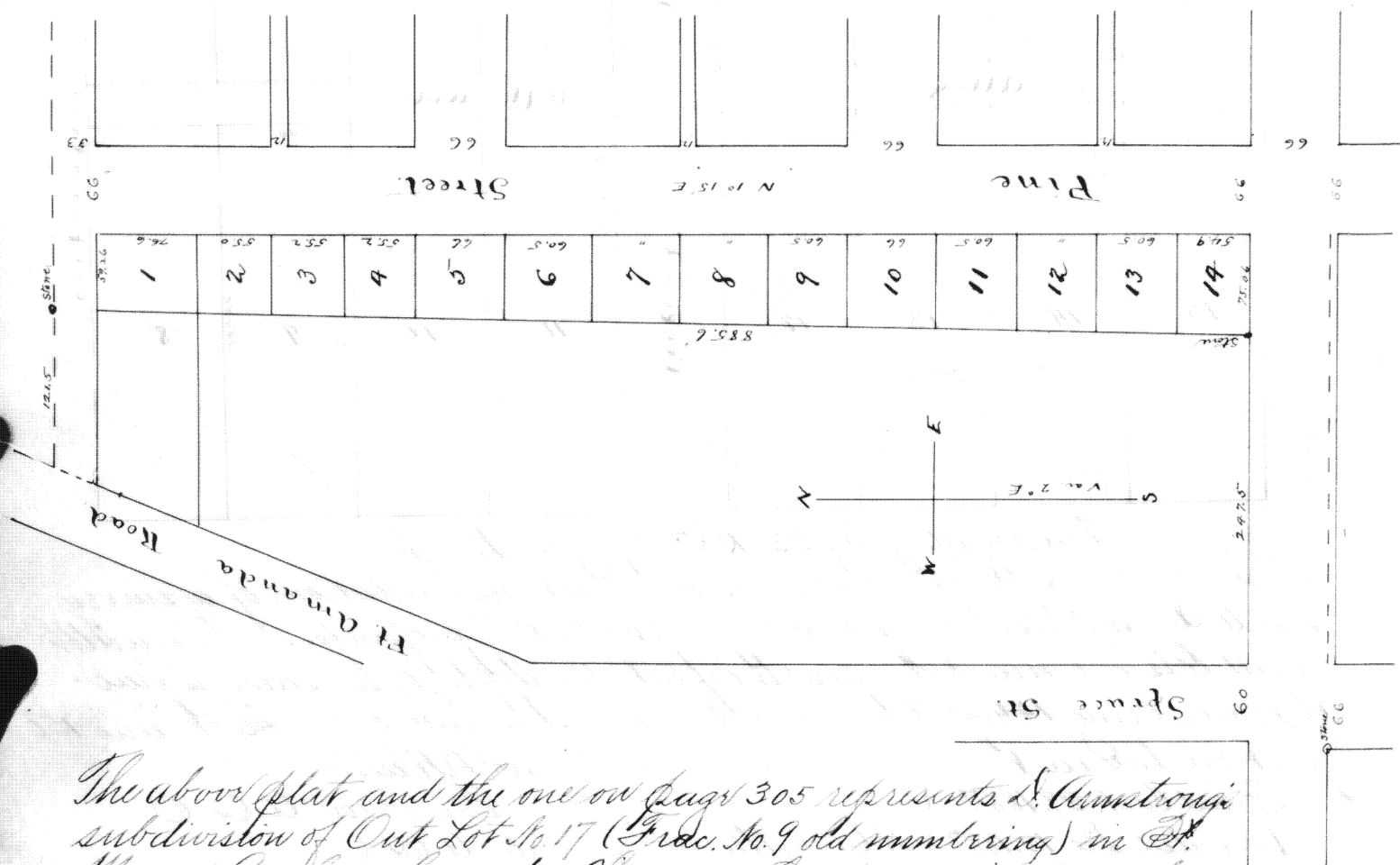

*D. Armstrongs Subdivision of Out Lot No. 17, St. Marys.*



The above plat and the one on page 305 represents D. Armstrongs subdivision of Out Lot No. 17 (Trac. No. 9 old numbering) in St. Marys, Auglaize County, Ohio. Scale: one inch = 100 feet.

I hereby certify that the above is a correct map of the subdivision of Out Lot No. 17 (Trac. No. 9 of old numbering, in the village of St. Marys, Auglaize County, Ohio, as surveyed and staked out by me for D. Armstrong, Esq. during April 1887. The Streets and Avenues are 66 feet wide except Oil and Gas streets which are as noted. Alleys are 12 feet wide. Pine, Pear, Vine and Scott Sts. are continuations of the same in Armstrongs East Addition. Oil St. and Cleveland and Hendricks Aves. are parallel with Columbia Street. The dimensions are given in feet and hundredths.
