I hereby certify that the above map is a correct representation of Heusch, Huffman + Co's Addition to the Village of St. Marys, Auglaize County, Ohio, as surveyed and plotted by me during April 1888. It covers $14\frac{3}{4}$ acres off the South east part of Sec. 14, T6E. R4E, lots 73+74 of West Addition and lots 26, 27, 28, 29+30 of Joseph Burdington's subdivision of Duman & Donnan's subdivision. The streets are continuations of the same in West Addition. Dimensions are indicated by feet and hundredths. Courses in degrees and minutes. Variation of compass 2° east. St. Marys, Ohio. 4/27/88. E. M. Vanfleet, C.E.

The Streets are all 66 feet wide, alleys are 12 feet wide. Stones are placed at the south east corner of Lot 80 (being also the south east corner of Section four (4), T6E. R4E) and at the north west corner of Lot 8. E. M. Vanfleet, C.E.
