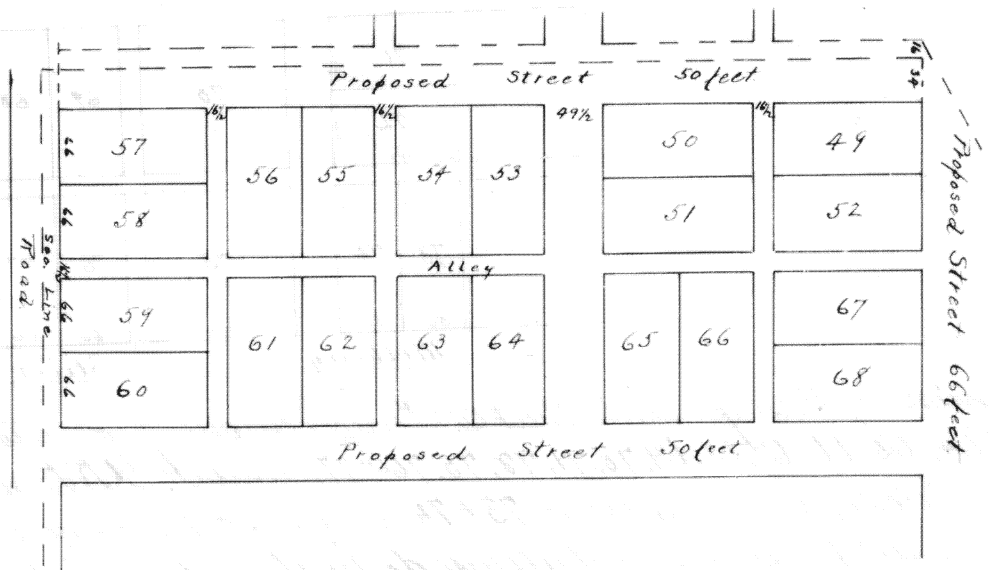


*First Addition to New Hampshire, O.
