the Hamlet of New Knoxville, Ohio, to a village.

To William Kuck, William Henschel and Henry Kuhlman. Trustees of said hamlet of New Knoxville, Ohio:

The undersigned respectfully represent that they are electors and inhabitants of that portion of said hamlet desired to be advanced to a village, hereinafter described; that a majority of them, to wit: those so marked after their signatures hereto are freeholders: That they desire that the following described portion of the territory now composing said hamlet be advanced to a village, to wit: the North west quarter of the north west quarter of Section twenty nine (29) containing 40 acres more or less; also the east half of the east half of the north east quarter of Section thirty (30) containing 40 acres more or less. and also three and one half (3 1/2) Acres, being twenty rods north and south by 24 rods east and west out of the south east corner of the south west quarter of the South west quarter of Section 20, all in town 6 south, range 5 east, Washington Township, Auglaize County, Ohio. The said portion of said hamlet contains the requisite population for a village, and that it is the desire of the inhabitants of said hamlet that said portion be so advanced. Your petitioners therefore respectfully pray your Honorable Board to cause an election to be held to obtain the sense of the electors upon the question of such advancement and to take such other steps as are provided by law in such cases. 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Regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of New Knoxville, Ohio, held June 28, 1890. Present: Trustees Cook, Henschel and Kuhlman and Holtkamp, Clerk. Minutes of previous meeting were read and approved. A petition signed by E. L. Kattman et al. was presented to trustees, in the matter of the advancement of a portion of the hamlet of New Knoxville to a village. Upon examination Trustees were satisfied that the persons who signed it are electors and reside within the corporation and that the majority of them are free holders, and consequently fixed the place and time for holding the election to be held in the election house of our hamlet on the first Monday of August AD 1890 and instructed Clerk Holtkamp to cause notice of said election according to law. Adjourned to next subject to call.

Special meeting of Board of Trustees of hamlet of New Knoxville, Auglaize County, Ohio, held August 4th, 1890, after election. Present: Trustees Henschel, Cook and Kuhlman, and Holtkamp Clerk. The object of this meeting being to take further steps in the matter of the advancement of a portion of the Hamlet to a village. As per previous resolution the election being held on the above date, notice of same having been duly given. The number of electors who voted at said election is 72. The number cast "For Village" is 39; the number cast "Against village" is 33. On motion it was agreed in the meeting that Herman Kattman be appointed census enumerator to take the census in the manner prescribed by law. On motion adjourned to meet Saturday evening August 9th 1890.

Special meeting of Board of Trustees of New Knoxville Ohio, held Aug. 9th 1890. Present: Trustees Henschel, Cook and Kuhlman, and Holtkamp, Clerk. Minutes of last two previous meetings were read and approved. Herman Kattman laid before the Board a certified census report as per previous motion, which was accepted and Mr. Kattman discharged. It was ascertained by such census that the whole number of inhabitants in the corporation is three hundred and twenty one. On motion Clerk Holtkamp was instructed to prepare the necessary transcript of the journal entries and proceedings in behalf of this advancement and a majority of the trustees having signed it, deliver the same with the census, poll book and tally sheet to the county Recorder. On motion adjourned to meet subject to call.
