


Plat of Wm. Axe subdivision of the South part of Out Lot No. 125,

Incorporation of Buckland.

In the matter of the incorporation of Whitefeather as the village of Buckland for all purposes } Petition for incorporation of the town of Whitefeather under and by the name of Buckland, Ohio.

To the Hon. the Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, O.
Gentlemen: We the undersigned resident inhabitants, citizens and electors of the town now known as Whitefeather and residing on the territory hereinafter described, would respectfully represent to your Hon. Body that we desire and request that the following described territory, a large portion of which has been laid out in lots a plat of which has been made and duly acknowledged and recorded, to wit: The East half of the North East quarter of Section No. 10; the west fractional half of the North West quarter of Sec. No. eleven (11) in town No. four (4) south of Range No. 5 east in Auglaize County, Ohio, be changed from the name of Whitefeather to that of Buckland and organized into an incorporated village by the name of Buckland in the State of Ohio. Your petitioners further request that the supposed number of resident inhabitants and citizens residing on said territory is about three hundred (300). We, the undersigned therefore desire and request that Fred Ziegenbush, Charles Ziegenbush and Dr. R. W. Sharp shall act as agents in our behalf in the premises. An accurate map of the above described territory is hereto attached. We therefore pray that said name of Whitefeather for said town be changed to that of Buckland and that the same be incorporated so as aforesaid asked.
