

Geyer City



Geyer City is laid out in the central part of the North West fractional quarter of Section 27, town 6 south, range 7 east, immediately north of the intersection of The Ohio Southern Railroad and Geyer Pike in Clay Township, Auglaize County, Ohio.

Streets are 60 feet and alleys are 16 1/2 feet wide, laid out at right angles. Size of lots and width of streets and alleys are given in feet. Iron pins are driven in center of pike 30 feet from south west corner of lot number one, and thirty feet from south east corner of lot number nine. Lime stones are set at north east corner of Maple Avenue and High Street, and north west corner of Elm Avenue and High Street.

I hereby certify that the above map represents correctly the work done on the ground by me Sept. 26th. 1893.
