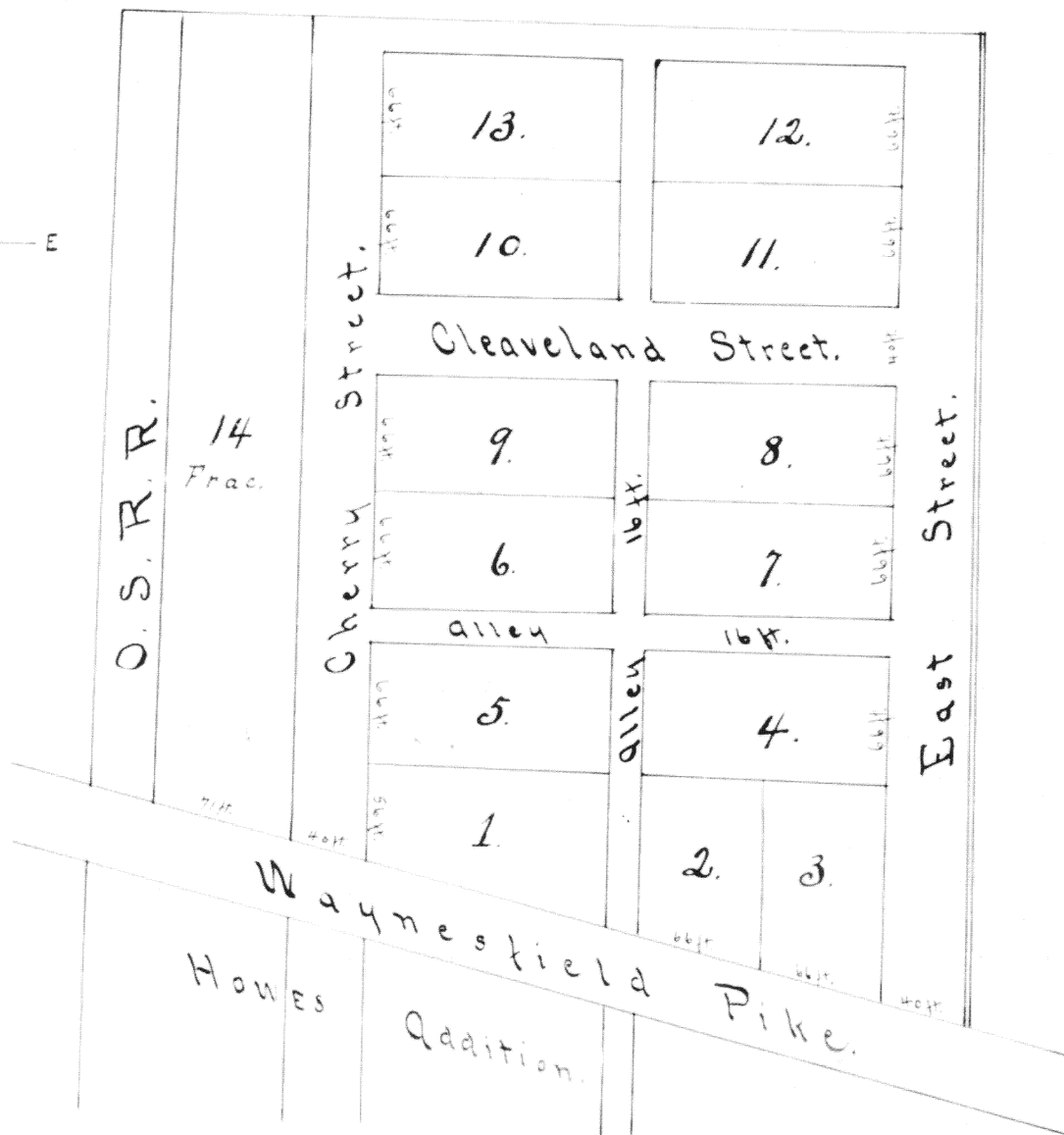
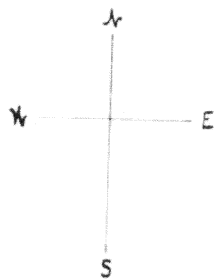


Fuchs Addition To UNIONPOLIS,
