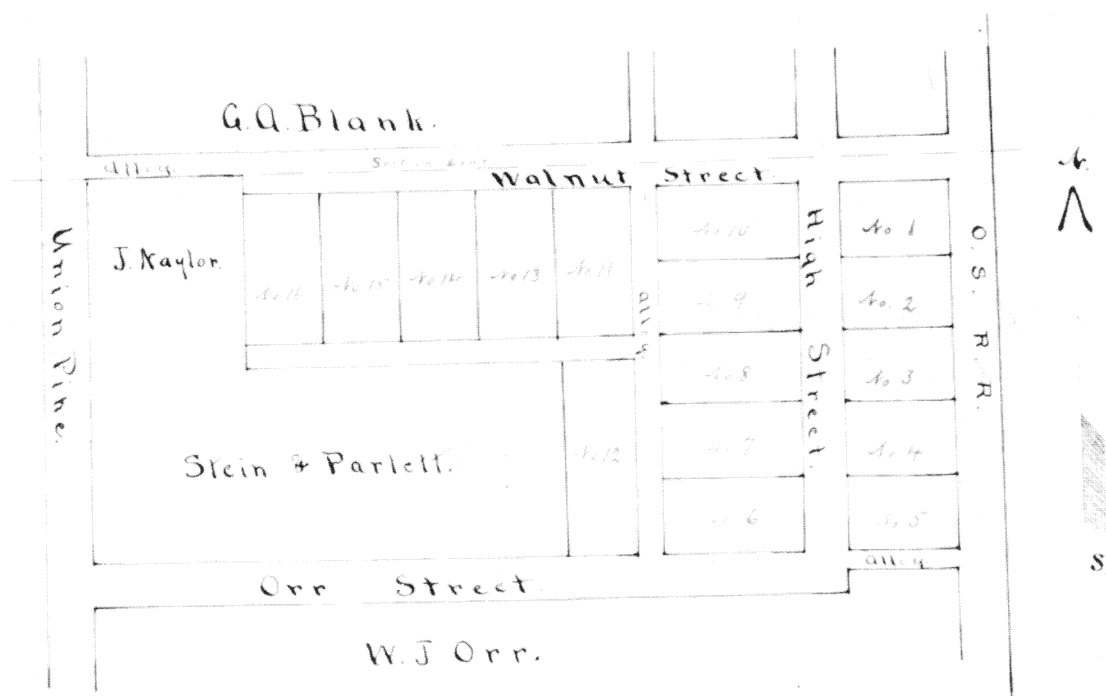


Parletts & Stein's Addition.

 The Village of Uniopolis. Ohio.



I hereby Certify the above Addition to the Village of Unionopolis, Auglaize County, Ohio, correctly shown. Being a part of Section 20. 5. S. R. 7 E. Beginning at a pile for a marker in the center of the Union Pike on Section line between Sections 20 and 17, running East to O. & P. R. Lots No. 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 are 64 ft. by 87 ft. facing West. Lots No. 6, 7, 8, 9 & 10 are 64 ft. by 117 ft. facing East. Lots No. 11, 13, 14, 15 are 65 ft. by 132 ft. facing North. Lot No. 16 is 65 ft. (more or less) face, by 132 depth, facing North. Lot No. 12 is 50 face by 188 1/2 ft. depth facing South. Streets are 33 ft. wide. Allways 16 ft. except allway between Lot No. 5 and N. J. Orr and G. A. Blank and J. Maylor which are 16 1/2 ft. wide.
