To the Hon. Commissioners of Highland County, Ohio:

To the Hon. Commissioners of Niagara, Sirs,
Your petitioners, the Mayor and Common Council of the
Incorporated Village of New Norville, Ohio, respectfully represent that at their reg-
ular session of said Council, by a resolution dated the second day of January, anno
Domini一千九百零二年, directed the Clerk to annex unto the Corporation thereof
to wit, The East half of the West half of the South East quarter of the South West
quarter of Section twenty six, Township six South Range five east, containing ten
acres more or less; Also the West half of the West half of the South East quarter of the South

taining ten acres more or less; Also the South West quarter of the South West quarter of
Section twenty six, Township six South Range five east, except three acres off
of the South East corner of said tract of land, and containing thirty seven (37)
acres more or less; Also the South East quarter of the South East quarter of
Section nineteen (19), Township six South Range six east, containing forty
acres more or less; Also the East half of the South West quarter of the South
East quarter of Section nineteen (19) Township six South Range five east, con-
taining twenty (20) acres more or less; Also the East half of the West half of the
South West quarter of the South East quarter of Section nineteen (19) Township six South
Range five east containing ten (10) acres more or less; Also the West half of the West half
of the South West quarter of the South East quarter of Section nineteen (19) Township six South
Range five east containing eighteen (18) acres more or less; Also the West half of
the South East quarter of the South East quarter of Section Twenty (20) Township six South
Range five east containing twenty (20) acres more or less; Also Out Lots
number fifteen (15), twenty (20), seventeen (17), eighteen (18), and sixteen (16). Said out lots
being fractional parts of the South East quarter of the South East quarter of Section
Thirty (30) Township six South Range five east; Also the South half of the West half
of the South East quarter of the South East quarter of Section Thirty (30) Township six South
Range five east, containing twenty (20) acres more or less; Also the South West quarter
of the North west quarter of Section twenty nine (29) Township six South Range five east
containing forty (40) acres more or less; Also the West half of the South east quarter of the
North West quarter of Section twenty nine (29) Township six South Range five east
containing twenty (20) acres more or less; Also the East half of the North East
quarter of the North West quarter of Section twenty nine (29) Township six South Range
five east, containing twenty (20) acres more or less; Also, the East half of the North west
quarter of the North west quarter of Section twenty nine (29) Township six South Range
five east, containing twenty (20) acres more or less. A correct plat of said territory
is herewith filed and marked "A", a copy of said Ordinance is hereto attached
and marked "B". Your Petitioners therefore pray that such proceedings
may be had by your Hon. Body as may be necessary to perfect the annex-
ation of said territory to said Village.

Ordinance No. 26.

New Knoxville, Ohio, June 10, 1895.

I- An Ordinance annexing territory to the Incorporated Village of New Knoxville, Ohio. Be it Ordained by the Council of the Incorporated Village of New Knoxville, Ohio, that the contiguous territory herein after named known and designated as Out Lots and subdivisions of Out Lots to the Incorporated Village of New Knoxville, Ohio, shall be annexed for general corporation purposes, and be made subject to all existing ordinances now, or which may hereafter be in force, to wit:

II- The East half of the West half of the South east quarter of the South west quarter of Section twenty (20) Township six (6) South, range five (5) east, containing ten (10) acres; Also, the west half of the west half of the South East quarter of the South west quarter of Section twenty (20) township six (6) south, range five (5) east, containing ten (10) acres; Also, the South west quarter of the South West quarter of Section Twenty (20) Township six (6) South, Range five (5) east, except three acres off of the South west corner of said tract of land, and containing thirty seven (37) acres more or less; Also the South East quarter of the South East quarter of Section nineteen (19) Township six (6) South, Range five (5) east, containing forty (40) acres more or less; Also, the East half of the South West quarter of the South East quarter of Section nineteen (19) Township six (6) South, range five (5) east, containing twenty (20) acres more or less; Also, the East half of the South west quarter of the South east quarter of Section nineteen (19) Township six (6) South, range five (5) east, containing ten (10) acres more or less; Also, the west half of the west half of the South west quarter of the South east quarter of Section nineteen (19) Township six (6) South, range five (5) east, containing forty (40) acres more or less; Also, the West half of the South east quarter of Section thirty, Township six (6) South, range five (5) east, containing eighty (80) acres more or less; Also the West half of the South east quarter of Section thirty (30) Township six (6) South, range five (5) east, containing twenty (20) acres more or less. Also Lot Lot numbers nineteen (19) seventeen (17) and sixteen (16), Said out Lots being fractional parts of the South east quarter of the South east quarter of Section thirty (30) Township six (6) South, range five (5) east. Also the South half of the West half of the South east quarter of the South east quarter of Section thirty (30) Township six (6) South, range five (5) east, containing twenty (20) acres more or less; Also the South west quarter of the South west quarter of Section twenty nine (29) Township six (6) South, range five (5) east, containing forty (40) acres more or less; Also the West half of the South east quarter of Section twenty nine (29) Township six (6) South, Range five (5) east, containing twenty (20) acres more or less; Also the East half of the South east quarter of the South west quarter of Section twenty nine (29) Township six (6) South, range five (5) east, containing ten (10) acres more or less; Also, the East half of the South West quarter of the South west quarter of Section twenty nine (29) Township six (6) South, range five (5) east, containing twenty (20) acres more or less.

III- Be it further ordained that C. H. Williamson is hereby appointed and authorized to prosecute all proceedings necessary to effect the annexation of the above-said territory for the uses and purposes therein mentioned.


II- This Ordinance to take effect and be in full force from and after its legal passage and publication.



September 3rd, 1895. Board met in regular session.

Present: Hm. Barth, J.W. Logan, J.S. Butcher. - P.D. Gordon Jr. Auditor.
In the matter of the Application of the Village of }
New Knopville for the Annexation of Territory }

On September 2nd 1895 came the Village of New Knopville by its duly authorized agent, C.W. Williamson, and filed with the Auditor of Auglaize County, Ohio, a petition and a plat of certain lands, asking for the annexation of certain territory therein described. The matter having been called to the attention of the Commissioners they set Saturday the 2nd day of November A.D. 1895 at 10 o'clock A.M. as the day and hour for the hearing of said petition, which said time was communicated to C.W. Williamson the Agent of said Village.

In the matter of the annexation of Territory to the } This being the day set for the
Village of New Knopville, Auglaize County, Ohio } hearing in the above named
matter and the hour having arrived, the Commissioners proceeded with the case. It
having been made to appear that the proper notice as required by law had been duly
given and a copy of said notice duly posted in a conspicuous place on said territory,
and an affidavit in proof thereof duly made and filed with the papers in this case, and
all preliminary steps necessary before hearing of said matter could be had having been
duly taken. The Village of New Knopville was represented by its Agent C.W. Williamson
And William Gledhill et al. interested persons and owners of a portion of the lands
sought to be annexed, filed a remonstrance thereto. After listening to the testimony
offered in the case, it was moved by J.W. Logan seconded by J.S. Butcher to adjourn
in the above matter until 10 o'clock A.M. November 7th 1895, vote called resulting as
follows: Hm. Barth, yes. J.W. Logan, yes. J.S. Butcher, yes.

Nov. 7, 1895, Board met in Special Session. Present: Hm. Barth, J.W. Logan, J.S. Butcher.

In the matter of the Annexation of Territory to the Village of New Knopville, Auglaize Co. O.

This being the day to which further proceeding in the above named matter were
adjourned and the hour having arrived the case was again called. The Board of Com-
missioners find that the petition contains all the matter required by law to be set out
and that its statements are true, that the limits of the proposed addition are not unrea-
sonably large and that the plat is accurate. Thereupon the Commissioners being of
the opinion that the prayer of the petition ought to be granted, do ordain and say that
the premises as described in said petition be, and the same are hereby annexed to and made
a part of the corporate limits of the Village of New Knopville. It is further ordered that
all orders and proceedings herein shall be entered on the official journal of said Board
and a certified transcript thereof signed by a majority of said Board be delivered to-
gether with the petition, map and all other papers filed, relating to the matter, to the
Recorder of Auglaize County, Ohio, at the earliest time practicable.
