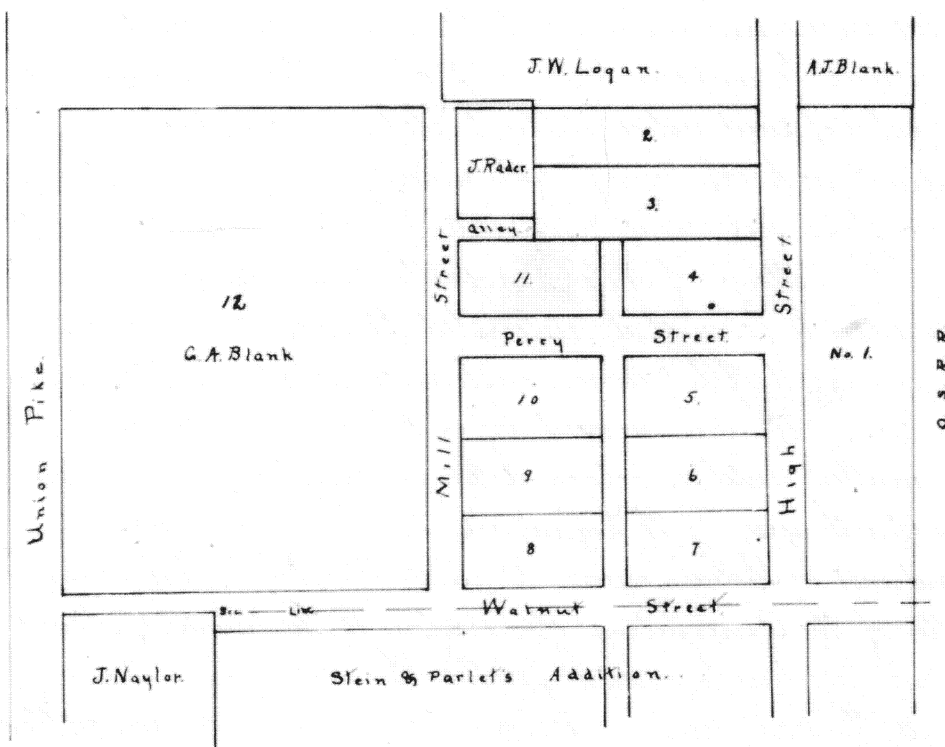
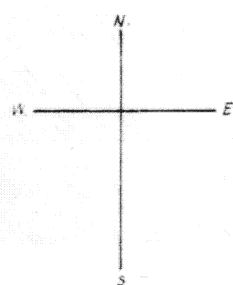


George A. Blank's

I hereby certify that the above Addition to the Village of Unionopolis, Auglaize County, Ohio, correctly shown, being a part of Section No. 17, T 5 S. R. 7 E, — beginning at a tile (for a marker) in the center of Union Pike on Section line between Sec. No. 17 & 20 running East to O. S. R. R.

Lot No. 1 is 25 rods facing High Street, with a depth of 87 feet.

Lot No. 2 is 3 rods facing High Street, with a depth of 184 feet.

Lot No. 3 is 4 rods facing High Street by a depth of 184 feet.

Lots No. 4, 5, 6 & 7 are 4 rods facing High Street by a depth of 117 feet.

Lots No. 8, 9, 10 & 11 are 4 rods facing Mill Street with a depth of 117 feet

Walnut St. and High St. are each 33 feet wide.

Mill Street 26 feet wide.

Alley between J. Naylor & L. A. Blank is 16 ft. wide.

Alley between J. Rader & Lot No. 11 is 15 ft. wide.

Alley between Mill & High Streets is 16 ft. wide.
