Petition For Annexation Of Territory.

To the Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio. - The Incorporated Village of Minster, Auglaize County, Ohio, hereby petitions your Honorable Body for the annexation of the territory herein-after described to said Village, and respectfully represents: 1st- That by an ordinance duly passed by the Council of said Village on the 19th day of December, 1898, and duly published as provided by law, the territory described as follows was authorized to be annexed thereto, to-wit: - Beginning on the west side of Ohio Street, and north side of Sixth Street, thirteen and seventeen hundredths (13.17) chains south of the center of Section Twenty-seven (27), Town Seven (7) south, Range Four (4) east; thence west, nine and ninety-three hundredths (9.93) chains to the west end of Out-Lot number Six (6), thence south on the west line of Out-Lots numbers Six (6), Five (5), Four (4), Three (3), Two (2) and One (1), to the south west corner of Out-Lot number One (1), twenty-six and thirty-three hundredths (26.33) chains; thence south parallel with Ohio Street, to an extension of the south line of Second Street, in Minster, Auglaize County, Ohio, twenty-seven and thirty-three hundredths (27.33) chains; thence east on said extended line to Ohio Street, nine and ninety-three hundredths (9.93) chains; thence north along the west side of said Ohio Street, fifty-three and sixty-six hundredths (53.66) chains, to the place of beginning. 2nd- That Samuel A. Hoskins, was authorized by said Village in said ordinance to prosecute the proceedings necessary to effect said annexation, and that a true copy of said ordinance authorizing said annexation is hereto attached, marked "Exhibit A." 3rd- That the plat accompanying this petition and marked "Territory to be Annexed" is an accurate map of said territory.

Exhibit "A" - Ordinance, No. 311. - To authorize the Annexation of Contiguous Territory. Be it Ordained by the Village Council of the Village of Minster, Ohio, as follows: Section 1. That the annexation to the Village of Minster, Ohio of the territory hereinafter described be, and the same is hereby authorized, to-wit: - Beginning on the west side of Ohio Street, and north side of Sixth Street, thirteen and seventeen hundredths (13.17) chains south of the center of Section (27), Town Seven (7) south, Range Four (4) east; thence west, nine and ninety-three hundredths (9.93) chains to the west end of Out-Lot number Six (6), thence south on the west line of Out-Lots numbers Six (6) Five (5) Four (4) Three (3) Two (2) and One (1), to the southwest corner of Out-Lot number one (1), twenty-six and thirty-three hundredths (26.33) chains; thence south parallel with Ohio Street, to an extension of the south line of Second Street, in Minster, Auglaize County, Ohio, twenty-seven and thirty-three hundredths (27.33) chains; thence east on said extended line to Ohio Street, nine and ninety-three hundredths (9.93) chains; thence north along the west side of said Ohio Street, fifty-three and sixty-six hundredths (53.66) chains, to the place of beginning. Section 2. - That Samuel A. Hoskins, Esq., of Wapakoneta, Ohio is hereby authorized to prosecute the proceedings necessary to affect said annexation. Section 3. - This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law. Done at the Council chamber in the Village of Minster, Ohio, on this 19th day of December, A.D. 1898.

Hoskins, its solicitor and duly authorized Agent, and presented its petition for the annexation of certain territory to said Village, fully set out and described in said petition, it is therefore ordered and directed at this a regular session of the Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio, that said petition be filed with the Auditor of Auglaize County, Ohio, and that the hearing of the same for the annexation of said territory be set down for the 9th day of May, 1899, at 10 o'clock A.M., at the Commissioners Office in Wapakoneta, Ohio. And the Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to notify the said Agent of said petitioners of the time and place of said hearing.

In the Matter of the Annexation

Board met in special session mem-

bers present. - Henry Hellbusch, Samuel Plummer and J. S. Butcher.

The Board proceeded by reading the minutes of the preceding meeting &c. The following Witnesses having been subpoenaed were then sworn, August Schunck, R. A. Ruhlman, Frank Schmucker, B. Sherman, Jno. Laufsweiler, Peter Niemeyer, Fred Kramer, August Herkenhoff, Henry Ruhlman, Benjamin Dickman, and N. A. Ley, testimony was then taken, after which the Board listened to the arguments of Attorneys in the case, and thereupon on motion the Board adjourned in said matter until June 7th 1899 at 10 o'clock A.M.

In the Matter of the Annexation
of Territory to the Village of
Minster, Ohio. ||

This day the commissioners met pursuant to an adjournment heretofore had in the above matter, and after having viewed said territory proposed for annexation and after having heard the evidence for and against said annexation and having heard the arguments of council thereon, and being fully advised in the premises, commissioners do find that the said petition filed herein contains all the matters required by law to be therein contained, that its statements are true, that the limits of the proposed annexation are accurately described and are not unreasonably large or small, that the map accompanying the petition is accurate, that the notice of the time and place of the hearing of said petition, containing the substance thereof, was published in the Auglaize County Democrat and the Minster Post, two newspapers printed and of general circulation in Auglaize County, Ohio, that said notice was published in both of said newspapers for six (6) consecutive weeks subsequent to the filing of the petition with the County Auditor, and prior to the date fixed for the hearing of said

petition, that a copy of said notice was posted in a conspicuous place within the limits of the said territory proposed to be annexed to said Village, that said copy was posted for six (6) weeks prior to the time fixed for such hearing, also that a like copy of said notice was posted within the Village of Minster, Auglaize County, Ohio, six (6) weeks prior to the time fixed for such hearing. The court further finds that all the necessary preliminary steps for the final hearing of said petition has been taken as provided by law, and that said petition for the annexation of said territory to the Village of Minster, Ohio, is now legally and properly before the Board of Commissioners for its determination. And it further appearing to the Board that it is right and proper that the prayer of said petition be granted, it is now hereby ordered that said prayer of said petition be granted, and that the following described territory, by virtue of the proceedings herein be, and the same is hereby annexed to the said Village of Minster, Auglaize County, Ohio, to-wit: Beginning on the west side of Ohio Street and north side of Sixth Street, thirteen and seventeen hundredths (13.17) chains, south of the center of Section Twenty-seven, (27) Town Seven (7) south, Range Four (4) east, thence west nine and ninety-three hundredths (9.93) chains to the west end of Out-lot number Six (6). thence south on the west line of Out-lots numbers Six (6), Five (5) Four (4) Three (3) Two (2) and One (1) to the southwest corner of Out-lot number One (1), twenty-six and thirty-three hundredths (26.33) chains; thence south parallel with Ohio Street, to an extension of the south line of Second Street, in Minster, Auglaize County, Ohio, twenty-seven and thirty-three hundredths (27.33) chains, thence east on said extended line to Ohio Street, nine and ninety-three hundredths (9.93) chains, thence north along the west side of said Ohio Street fifty-three and sixty-six hundredths (53.66) chains to the place of beginning. And it is further ordered that a certified transcript, signed by a majority of this Board, of all the orders and proceedings of this Board in relation to such incorporation be at once transmitted to the County Recorder, together with said petition, map and all other papers on file relating to said matter.
