To the Honorable Board of Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio. - Your petitioners represent to your honorable body that they desire to obtain an order for the organization of a Village in the territory hereinafter described, and state that each of the thirty persons whose names are subscribed to this petition are electors and bonafide residents and inhabitants of the territory proposed to be incorporated. That an accurate description of the territory embraced within the proposed corporation is as follows; Commencing 148½ feet West of the North West corner of the Original Plat of Uniopolis, Auglaize County, Ohio, running thence South parallel with the Section line to a point 369½ feet South of the Section line, between Sections 18 & 19, thence East parallel with the Section line to a point 148½ feet East of the East line of East Street, thence North parallel with East Street to the north line of the South half (½) of the South West quarter (¼) of Section Seventeen (17) thence West to the place of beginning. Your petitioners represent that plats of a portion of said territory have been acknowledged and recorded in the record of plats of said County, and an accurate map of the territory is filed herewith. That the supposed number of inhabitants residing in the proposed corporation is three hundred. Your petitioners have appointed Clement Ohler and authorized him to act as their agent in this behalf, and pray that your honorable body do upon a hearing hereof, cause to be entered on your journal an order incorporating the above described territory into a Village under and by the name of Uniopolis.

Journal Entry.

The Board of Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio, proceeding this day to hear the matter of the application of J. W. Logan, et al., for permission to organize a municipal corporation in the territory in their petition described; and the Board having heard the arguments and suggestions of the persons appearing for and against the granting of the prayer of the petition and having considered the affidavits presented with reference thereto, and having heard the arguments of

counsel employed by parties therein on both sides and being fully advised in the premises, do find that the said petition contains all the matters required by law to be contained therein, that its statements are true, that the name proposed for said corporation is appropriate, that the limits of the proposed corporation are accurately described and are not unreasonably large or small; that the plat accompanying said petition is accurate; that the persons, or at least more than thirty (30) of them, whose names are subscribed to said petition, are bona fide electors residing in the territory therein described; that a notice of the time and place of the hearing of said petition, containing the substance thereof, was published in *The Anglaize Republican*, a newspaper printed and of general circulation in this County of Anglaize, for six consecutive weeks subsequent to the filing of said petition, with the County Auditor, and that a copy of said notice was posted in a conspicuous place within the limits of said proposed corporation for six (6) weeks prior to the time fixed for such hearing; that the population of such proposed corporation is more than two hundred (200) bona fide residents. And it further appearing to the Board that it is right and proper that the prayer of said petition be granted, it is now hereby ordered that the said corporation may be organized as in said petition prayed. And it is further ordered that a certified transcript, signed by a majority of this Board, of all the orders and proceedings of this Board in relation to such corporation, be at once transmitted to the Recorder of Anglaize County, Ohio, together with said petition, plat, and all other papers on file relating to said matter.

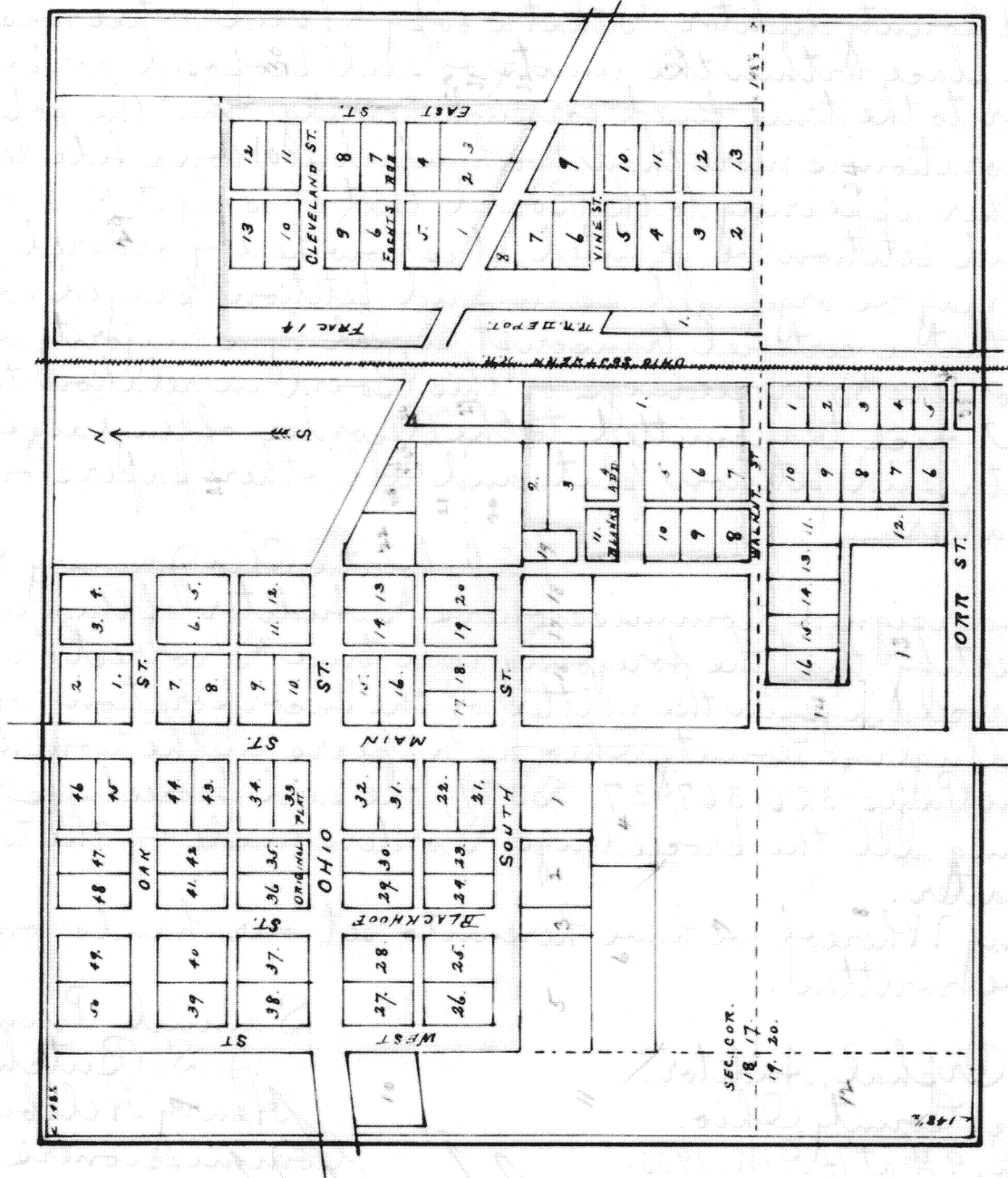
