Petition:

To the Honorable Board of Commissioners
of Auglaize County, Ohio.

Your petitioners represent to your
honorable body that they desire to obtain an order for the organization of
a village in the territory hereinafter described, and state that each of
the thirty persons whose names are subscribed to this petition are electors
and bona fide residents and inhabitants of the territory proposed to be
incorporated. That an accurate description of the territory embraced
within the proposed corporation is as follows:

Commencing 210 feet west of the intersection of the boundary line
and the north and south quarter line of Section 91, Town six south,
Range seven east, and running thence north $17\frac{1}{2}$ feet parallel with
the S. D. R. R. 2401 feet to the north line of said section; thence west on the
section line 1345 feet; thence south $17\frac{1}{2}$ east 2401 feet to the boundary
line; thence 1345 feet east to the place of beginning.

Your petitioners represent that a plat of a portion of said territory
has been acknowledged and recorded in the record of plats of said
County, and an accurate map of the territory is filed herewith. That
the number of inhabitants residing in such proposed corporation is
not less than two hundred. Your petitioners have appointed
James Killian and authorized him to act as their agent in this behalf
and pray that your Honorable Body do, upon a hearing hereof,
cause to be entered on your Journal in order to incorporate the above
described territory into a village under and by the name of Geyer.



J. D. Butcher, Henry Hellbusch, Samuel Plummer.

In the matter of the incorporation of the Village of Geyer: A petition for the incorporation of the village of Geyer was this day presented to the Board of Commissioners. Whereupon the Board ordered said petition filed and fixed the time for the hearing of the same on the 13th day of November 1900 at 10 o'clock A.M. at the Commission-
ers office Mapakoneta, Ohio.

The State of Ohio, Auglaize County, Nov. 13th 1900.

In the matter of the incorporation of the Village of Geyer, Ohio, - Journal Entry
The Board of Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio, proceeded this day
to hear the matter of the application of George Geyer and others for permission to organize
a municipal corporation in their territory in their petition described and having heard
the arguments and suggestions of the persons appearing for and against the granting
of the prayer of the petition, and having considered the affidavits presented with reference
thereto, and being fully advised, do find that the said petition contains all the
matter required by law to be contained therein; that its statements are true; that
the name proposed for said corporation is appropriate; that the limits of the pro-
posed corporation are accurately described and are not unreasonably large or
small; that the map accompanying the petition is accurate; that the persons
or at least thirty of them whose names are subscribed thereto are electors residing
on the territory therein described; that a notice of the time and place of hearing
the same, containing the substance thereof, was published in the Auglaize
County Republican, a newspaper printed and of general circulation in
this County, for six consecutive weeks subsequent to the filing thereof with the
county Auditor, and that a copy of said notice was posted in a conspicuous
place within the limits of said proposed corporation for six weeks prior to the
time fixed for such hearing; that the population of such proposed corpora-
tion is more than two hundred, and it further appearing to the Board
that it is right and proper that the prayer of said petition be granted, it
is now hereby ordered that the said corporation may be organized as in
said petition prayed. And it is further ordered that a certified transcript,
signed by a majority of this Board, of all the orders and proceedings of this
Board in relation to such corporation be at once transmitted to the
County Recorder, together with said petition, map, and all other papers on
file relating to said matter.
