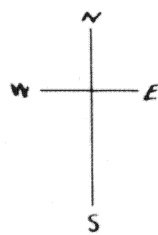
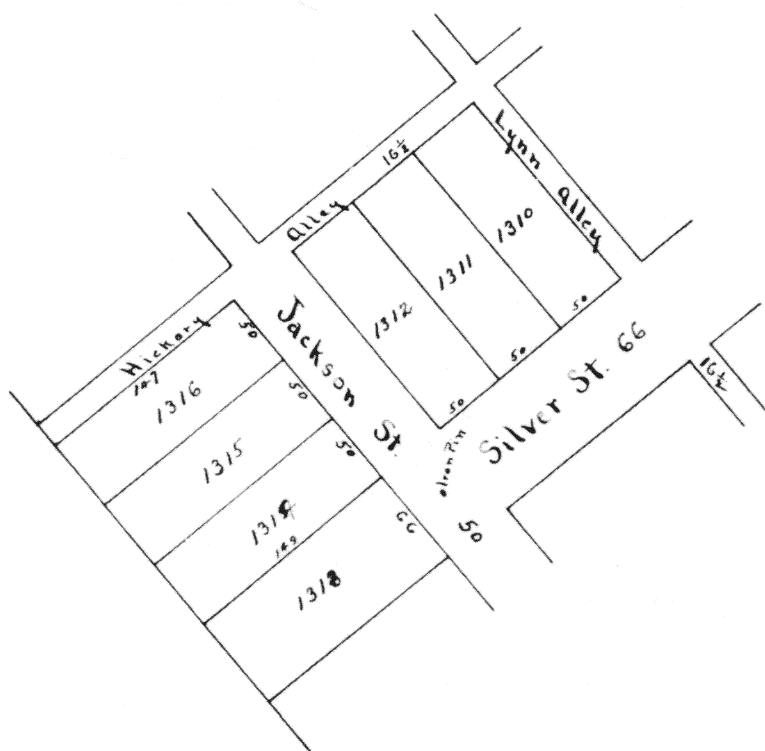


Nagel's Sub-division- Wapakoneta.
