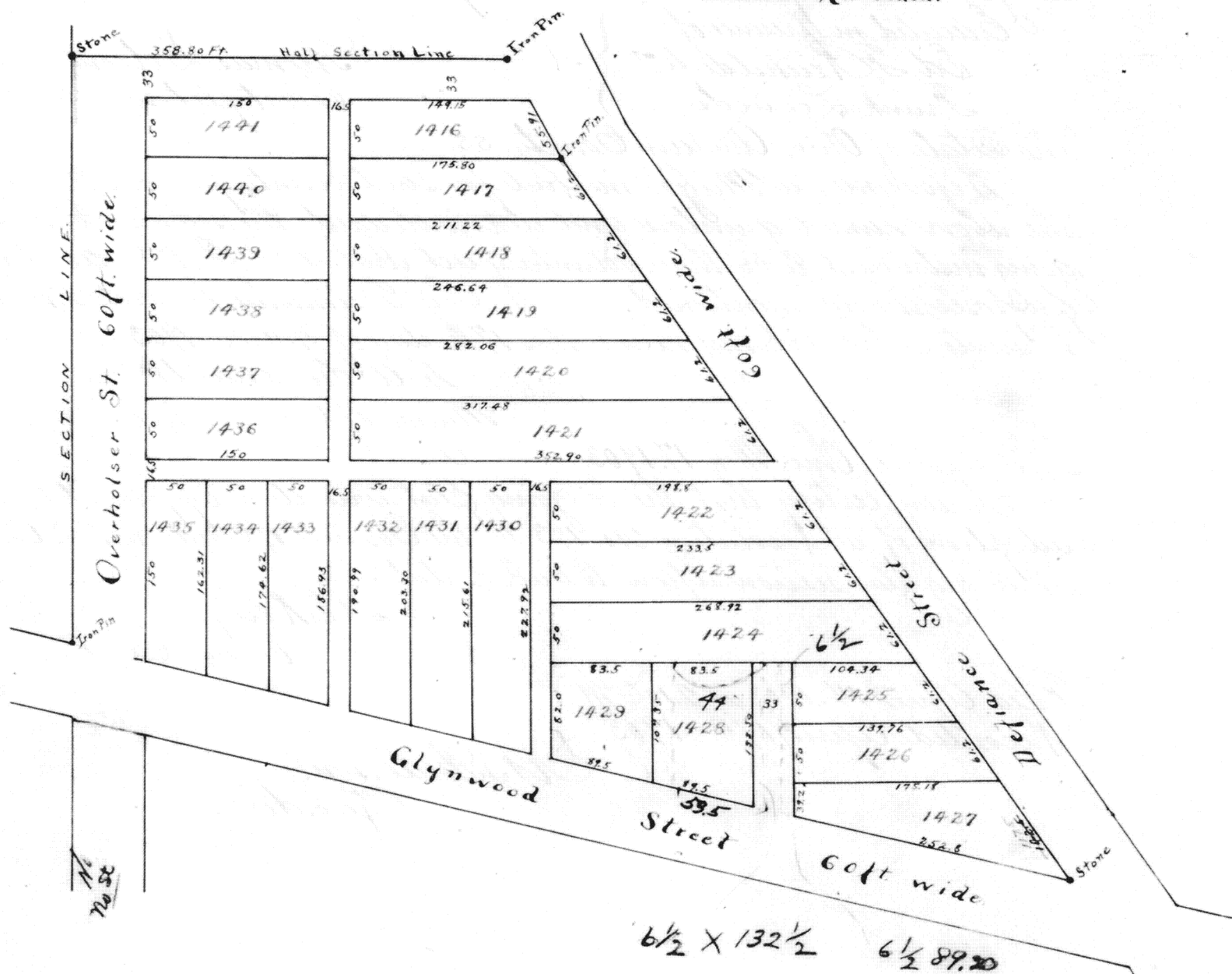


Plat of
