



Petition for the Annexation of Territory:
To The Commissioners of Augsberg County, State of Ohio.

The Village of New Bremen, respectfully represents that by an ordinance duly passed by its council on the 3rd day of May, A.D., 1904, the following described territory, except so much thereof as is already within the corporate limits of the incorporated Village of New Bremen, Augsberg County, Ohio, situate in the Township of German, Augsberg County and State of Ohio, to-wit:

Commencing at the south west corner of the north east quarter of the north east quarter of the south west quarter of Section Fifteen (15), Town Seven (11) North, Range Four (4) East; and running thence north fifty nine hundred and forty (5940) feet to the east and west quarter line of Section Ten (10), at a point six hundred and sixty (660) feet west of the east quarter corner of said section; thence east on the quarter line 2480 feet; thence south six hundred and sixty (660) feet to the north line of Lot No. Thirteen (13) of Schneider's Subdivision; thence east fifteen hundred (1500) feet to the north east corner of the south west quarter of the north west quarter of the south west quarter of Section Eleven (11); thence South fifty-two hundred and eighty (5280) feet to the south east corner of the north west quarter of the north west quarter of the south west quarter of Section Fourteen (14); thence West thirty nine hundred and sixty to the beginning." Was authorized to be annexed to said Village, an accurate map of which territory is hereto attached; that Thos. H. Tangeman was duly authorized to prosecute the proceedings to effect said annexation. Said Village respectfully petitions that said territory may be annexed to said Village.

This day the Board proceeded to hear the matter of the annexation of certain contiguous territory to the Village of New Bremen, Ohio, as prayed for in the petition of said village herein, and having heard the arguments and suggestions of the persons appearing for and against the granting of the prayer of said petition, and being fully advised, do find that the said petition contains all the matter required by law to be contained therein, that its statements are true, and the map accompanying the petition is accurate, that a notice of the time and place of the hearing of said petition, containing the substance thereof, was published in the "Star and Westchester Ohio", a newspaper printed and of general circulation in said village, and in this county, for six consecutive weeks, subsequent to the filing thereof with the County Auditor, and that a copy of said notice was posted in a conspicuous place within the limits of the territory proposed to be annexed, for six weeks prior to the time fixed for such hearing and it further appearing to the Board that it is right and proper, that the prayer of said petition be granted, it is now hereby ordered that the territory in said petition described, except that part lying West of the Canal and south of the present south Corporation line, be and the same hereby is annexed to the said Village of New Bremen, Ohio. And it is further ordered that a certified transcript, signed by a majority of this Board, of all the orders and proceedings of this Board in relation to such annexation be at once transmitted to the County Recorder, together with said petition, map and all other papers relating to said matter, as provided by the Statutes in such case made and provided.
