Shereby certify that the following is a true and correct copy of Ordinance No. 949, passed by the City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, on the 7th day of October, 1914, as the same will be found recorded in Volume 1 Pages 73 & 74 of the Ordinances of said City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, and published in the Auglaize County Democrat, the Wapakoneta Daily News, and Auglaize Republican for October 15, 1914.

Ordinance No. 949.

Consenting to the Detachment of Certain Territory from the City of Wapakoneta, Ohio.

Whereas a majority of the free hold electors owning land in a certain portion of territory of the City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, hereinafter described, having filed a petition with the board of Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio, praying to have such portion of territory detached from said City and attached to the Township of Duchonguet contiguous thereto; and

Whereas, said territory to be detached consists mainly of unplatted farm lands and in the opinion of the Council it will not be detrimental to the general interests to detach said territory; therefore Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Wapakoneta, State of Ohio, as follows:-

Sec. 1.- That the consent of the Council of said City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, is hereby given to the detachment from said City of the following territory situate located within the corporate limits of said City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, and also in the Southwest quarter and the Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-eight (28), Town Five (5) South Range Six (6) East of Duchonguet Township Auglaize County, Ohio, and bounded and described as follows:-

Commencing at a point in said City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, on the Section line between Section 28 and 33, Town 5 South, Range 6 East, said point of beginning being 660 feet East on the Northwest corner of said Section 33; thence running east on the Section line 990 feet to a point; thence North parallel with the West Section line of said Section 28, 1320 feet to a point; thence east parallel with the north Section line of Section 28, above described, 992 feet to a point; thence north parallel with the west Section line of Section 28, above described, 2720 feet to the north bank of the Engleize River; thence west and Northwest following the meandering of the said north bank to a point where it intersects the west line of Section 28; thence south on the section line 1246 feet to a point; thence east at a right angles to said Section line 82 1/2 feet to a point, being the northeast corner of Lot Number 1 of Elliott's Sub-Division; thence South on said east lot line 291 feet, more or less, to a point; thence east on the north side of an alley 257 1/2 feet to a point; thence south 20 feet; thence east 330 feet to a point; thence south 1320 feet along the east line of Necker's Sub-Division to a point, the place of beginning; said Territory above described to be attached to the Township of Duchiquet continuous thereto.

Sec. 2 - That said Commissioners of Engleize County, Ohio, are hereby requested to take no steps to ascertain and apportion the amount of existing indebtedness of said City, Township to which said territory is to be attached, said apportionment is required by law to be made by the City and said Township, not being required by said City to assume or pay any of the existing indebtedness of said municipal corporation.

Sec. 3 - That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest day allowed by law.

Petition

To the Honorable Board of Commissioners
of Engleize County, Ohio.

We, the undersigned, being a majority of the free-holder electors and all owning lands in that portion of the territory of the City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, hereinafter accurately described, petition your honorable board to have said portion of the territory detached from said City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, and to attach the same to Duchouquet Township, State of Ohio, which said township is adjoining and continuous thereto.

A plat of said territory herein praying for to be detached is hereto attached and made a part hereof. Said territory is located within the corporate limits of the City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, and also in the South-west quarter and the North-west quarter of Section Twenty-eight (28), Town Five (5) South, Range Six (6) East of Duchouquet Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, and bounded and described as follows:-

The undersigned, Sabina Distelrath, is the surviving widow, and Mary J. Joffe is the sole surviving child and heir at law of the above named John Distelrath and J. D. Distelrath, being one and the same, who died intestate.

The undersigned, Jacob P. Seitz, Dora Seitz and William H. Seitz, are three of the four children and heirs at law and devisees under the last will and testament of John C. Seitz, deceased, formerly owner of Q. 1. 63 and Lot 4 above described.

Said petitioners further state that said territory therein described consists of unplatted farm lands which were annexed to said municipality after the incorporation thereof more than five (5) years ago; that said land receives no material benefit by reason of being within the corporate limits by way of light, water or police protection; that said City of Wapakoneta has not grown and probably will not grow for many years to come in the direction in which said lands are situated; that the owners of said land are taxed and will continue to be taxed thereon for municipal purposes in substantial excess of the benefit conferred by reason of such lands being in the municipality; and that said lands may be detached without materially affecting the best interests of the good government of said City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, or of the Territory therein adjacent to that sought to be detached.

By agreement with the authorities of said City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, the undersigned petitioners further requires your honorable board to take no steps to ascertain and appropriate the amount of existing indebtedness of said City from which the detachment is made and which amount should be assumed and paid by Duchiquet Township to which said territory is to be attached, said appointment is required by law, hereby being waived by the City and the undersigned and all parties concerned. Wherefore, the undersigned petitioners pray your honorable board that said lands may be detached from said City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, and be attached to the adjacent township of Duchiquet in said County of Auglaize, and for all other relief to which they may be entitled.

The foregoing petition was presented to the Board and after reading same and being satisfied that said petition is signed by a majority of the freehold electors owning lands in the portion of the territory sought to be detached and finding that said territory has been accurately described in the petition accompanied by a map thereof and further finding that the account of the City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, has been given through an ordinance passed

and all parties affected having agreed to waive the appointment of
the amount of existing indebtedness against the City of Chaplanta,
Ohio, from which the detachment is sought to be made. It was thereupon
moved by C. H. Dixon seconded by W. M. Grey that the territory
described in the foregoing petition be detached from the City of
Chaplanta, Ohio and added to the taxable valuation of Duchauquet
Township, Cuyahoga County, Ohio.
