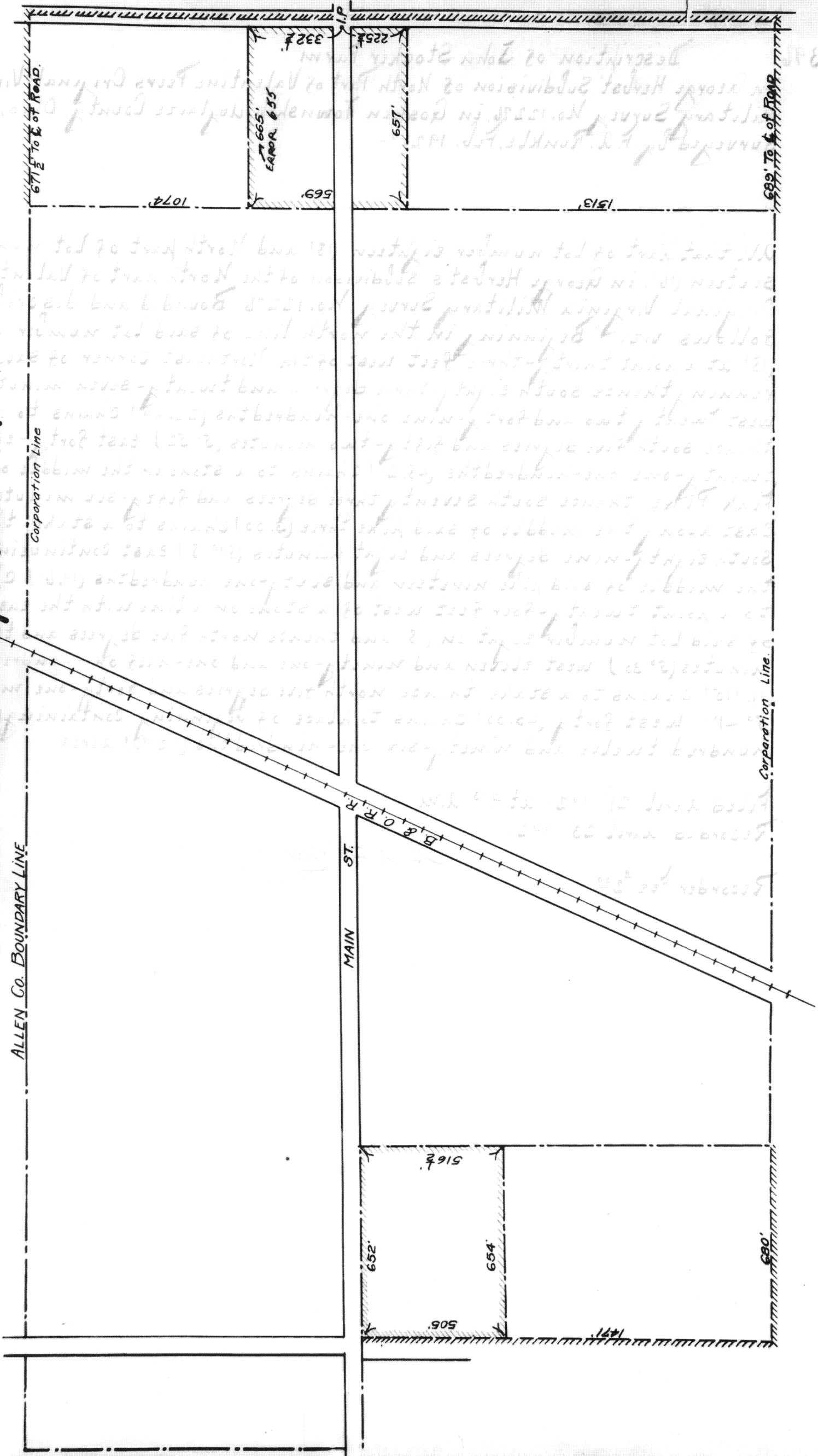


**PROPOSED ADDITION.
TO
CRIDERSVILLE CORPORATION.**

Wapakoneta, Ohio December 5, 1921.
To The Commissioners of Auglaize County, State of Ohio

The incorporated Village of Cridersville, in Auglaize County, Ohio, respectfully represents that by an Ordinance duly passed by the Council of said Village, on the 4th day of October, 1921 the following described territory,

Situated in the Township of Duchouquet, County of Auglaize and State of Ohio,

Tract No. 1: Commencing at what is now the Northeast corner of the corporation line of said Village of Cridersville, Ohio which is on the County line between Auglaize and Allen Counties, in the State of Ohio; thence in an Easterly direction along the County line between Auglaize and Allen Counties, a distance of six hundred and seventy-one and five tenths (671.5) feet to the center line of the road running North and South; thence South along the center line of said road, a distance of twenty-five hundred and eighty-seven (2587) feet to the half section line of Section Thirty-five (35); thence in a Westerly direction a distance of six hundred and eighty-nine (689) feet to the Southeast corner of the present corporation line of said Village; thence North along the present East corporation line of said Village, to the place of beginning.

Also,

Situated in the Township of Duchouquet, County of Auglaize and State of Ohio,

Commencing at the Southwest corner of the present corporation line of the said Village of Cridersville in Auglaize County Ohio; thence West along the half section line of Section Thirty-four (34) a distance of six hundred eighty (680) feet to the East line of the right of way of the Western Ohio Railway Company; thence North along said East line of said right of way, a distance of fourteen hundred and twenty-one (1421) feet to a point where this would intersect with the corporation line of said Village on Main Street; thence East along said corporation line to the West line of said corporation; thence South along said corporation line to the place of beginning, was authorized to be annexed to said Village.

An accurate map of which territory is hereto attached, marked "Exhibit A"

The said Village respectfully petitions that said territory may be annexed to said Village.

In the matter of the Petition filed for the Annexation of certain territory
in the Village of Cridersville, in Auglaize County, Ohio. Adjournment
on hearing for annexation proceedings for Village of Cridersville.

The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio, met
this day in special session.

Members present: J. W. Brackney, P. F. Grassle, E. H. Youngs.

The Commissioners of the County of Auglaize, State of Ohio, proceeding
this day to hear the Petition of the incorporated Village of Cridersville
in Auglaize County, Ohio, to obtain the annexation of the territory in said
Petition described, to the incorporated Village of Cridersville, in Auglaize
County, Ohio and having in open meeting heard all the persons desiring to
be heard for or against the granting of said Petition and considering the

Affidavits presented with reference thereto and all the evidence, and being fully advised in the premises, find that said Petition contains all the matter required by law that its statements are true: that the territory sought to be annexed is adjacent to the said Village of Cridersville, Ohio; that the Petition contains a full description of said territory; that the map of said territory attached to the Petition is accurate: that the required legal notice of the Petition has been given and that it is right and proper that said Petition should be granted, as to the following portion of the territory sought to be annexed, viz:

Commencing at an iron pin (Harrow Tooth) in the center of the County road extending eastward from main Street in the Village of Cridersville Auglaize County Ohio and twenty-five (25) feet west of its intersection with the center line of a north and south road commonly known as Lima - Wapakoneta road thence south on a line parallel with said Lima - Wapakoneta road two hundred and twenty-five and one-half ($225\frac{1}{2}$) feet to a point, thence west on a line parallel with said County road six hundred and fifty-seven (657) feet to the present north and south corporation line of said Village. Thence north along the present corporation line five hundred and sixty-nine (569) feet to a point: thence east six hundred and sixty-five (665) feet to a point twenty-five (25) feet west of the center line of said Lima - Wapakoneta road, thence south parallel with said Lima - Wapakoneta road, three hundred and thirty-two and one-half ($332\frac{1}{2}$) feet to place of beginning;

Also:

Beginning at a point twenty-five (25) feet south of the center line of Main Street in the Village of Cridersville, Auglaize County Ohio, said point being where the present corporation line running west meets the present corporation line running south, thence south along the present corporation line five hundred and sixteen and one-half ($516\frac{1}{2}$) feet to the southwest corner of lot number twelve (12) in Dotson & Stupleton's Addition to said Village, thence west six hundred and fifty-four (654) feet to east line of a north and south road thence north along the east line of said north and south road six hundred and five feet to the present corporation line running east and west. Thence east along the present corporation line six hundred and fifty-two (652) feet to place of beginning.

It is hereby ordered that the prayer of said Petition as to the remainder of said territory sought to be annexed be refused, and that the portion of the territory described in said Petition, as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin (Harrow Tooth) in the center of the County road extending eastward from main Street in the Village of Cridersville Auglaize County Ohio and twenty-five (25) feet west of its intersection with the center line of a north and south road commonly known as Lima - Wapakoneta road thence south on a line parallel with said Lima - Wapakoneta road two hundred and twenty-five and one-half ($225\frac{1}{2}$) feet to a point, thence west on a line parallel with said County road, six hundred and fifty-seven (657) feet to the present north and south corporation line of said Village. Thence north along the present corporation line five hundred and sixty-nine (569) feet to a point. Thence east six hundred and sixty-five (665) feet to a point twenty-five (25) feet west of the center line of

said Lima-Wapakoneta road, thence south parallel with said Lima-Wapakoneta road, three hundred and thirty-two and one-half ($332\frac{1}{2}$) feet to place of beginning;
Also:

Beginning at a point twenty-five (25) feet south of the center line of Main Street in the Village of Oridusville, Auglaize County, Ohio said point being where the present corporation line running west meets the present corporation line running south, thence south along the present corporation line, five hundred and sixteen and one-half ($516\frac{1}{2}$) feet to the southwest corner of lot number twelve (12) in Dotson & Steplton's Addition to said Village, thence west six hundred and fifty-four (654) feet to east line of a north & south road thence north along the east line of said north & south road five hundred and five feet to the present corporation line running east & west, thence east along the present corporation line six hundred and fifty-two (652) feet to place of beginning.

shall be & the same is hereby annexed to the said incorporated Village of Oridusville, Ohio in accordance with the law, & that a certified transcript signed by a majority of this Board of all the orders & proceedings of this Board relative to said Petition & hearing thereon, together with said Petition & map attached thereto, & as amended, & of all the papers on file relating to said matter, be deposited with the Clerk of said Village.
