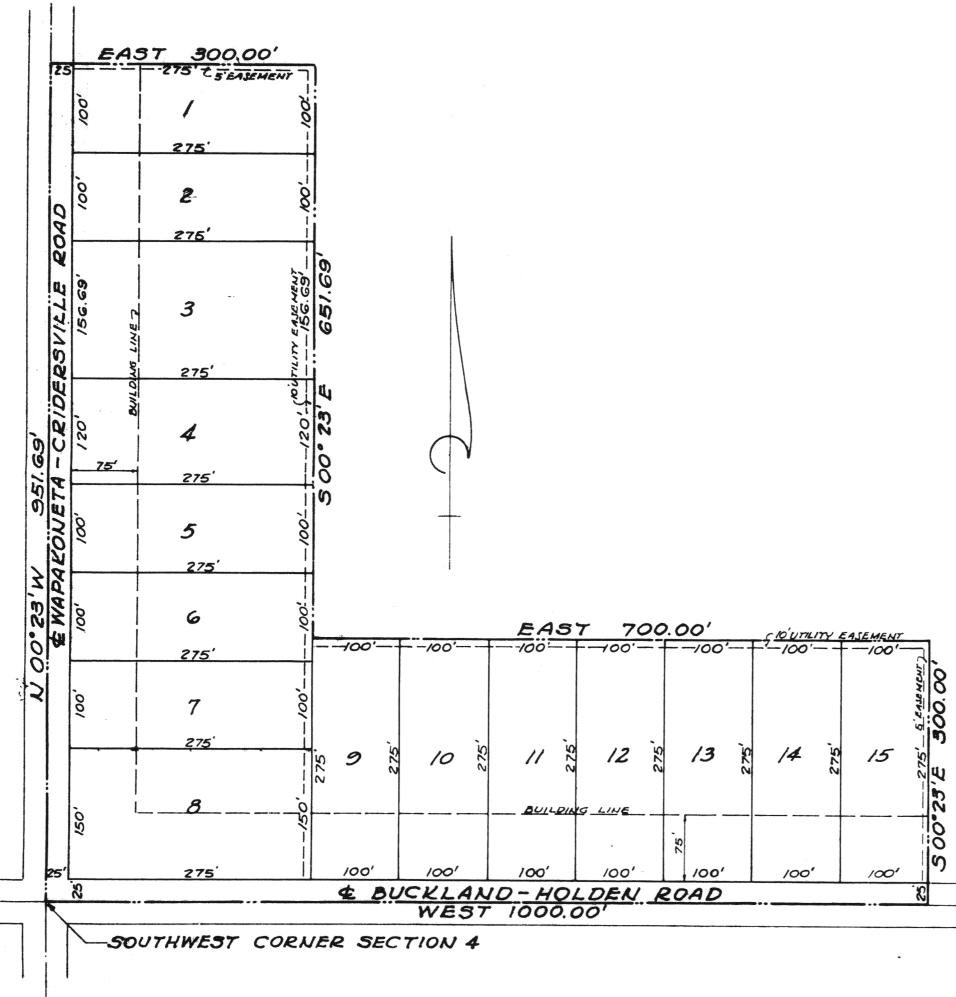

Beginning at the southwest corner of Section 4, being the intersection of the centerlines of the Wapakoneta-Cridersville and the Buckland-Holden Roads; thence N 00°-238W with the centerline of the Wapakoneta-Cridersville Road 951.69 feet; thence Due Rest 700.00 feet; thence S 00°-23'E 651.69 feet; thence Due Rest 700.00 feet; thence S 00°-23'E 300.00 feet to the centerline of the Buckland-Holden Road; thence Due West with the said centerline 1000.00 feet to the place of beginning.

PROTECTIVE COVENANTS AND RESTRICTIONS

- 1. These covenants and restrictions are for the benefit of all lot owners and are to run with the land, and shall be binding on all parties and persons claiming under them until December 31, 1982 at which time said covenants shall be automatically extended for successive periods of ten (10) years unless by a vote of a majority of the then owners of the lots, it is agreed to change said covenants in whole or in part.
- 2. It shall lawful for William H. Smith and Ethel J. Smith, or any other persons, firm or corporation owning any real estate situated in Smith Subdivision, to prosecute any proceedings at law or in equity against the person or persons, firm or corporationviolating or attempting to violate my covenant or restriction herein contained, and either to prevent him or them from so doing, or to recover damages or other dues from such violation.
- 5. No noxious or offensive trade shall be carried on upon any lot, nor shall anything be done thereon which may be or become an anneyance to the neighbrhood.
- 4. No trailer, basement, temt, shack, garage, barn or other outbuildings erected on the tract shall at any time be used as a residence, temporarily or permanently, nor shall any structure of a temporary nature be used as a residence.
- 5. The ground floer area of the main structure, exclusive of one story open porches and garages, shall not be less than one thousand (1000) square feet in the case of a one story or eight hundred (800) square feet
