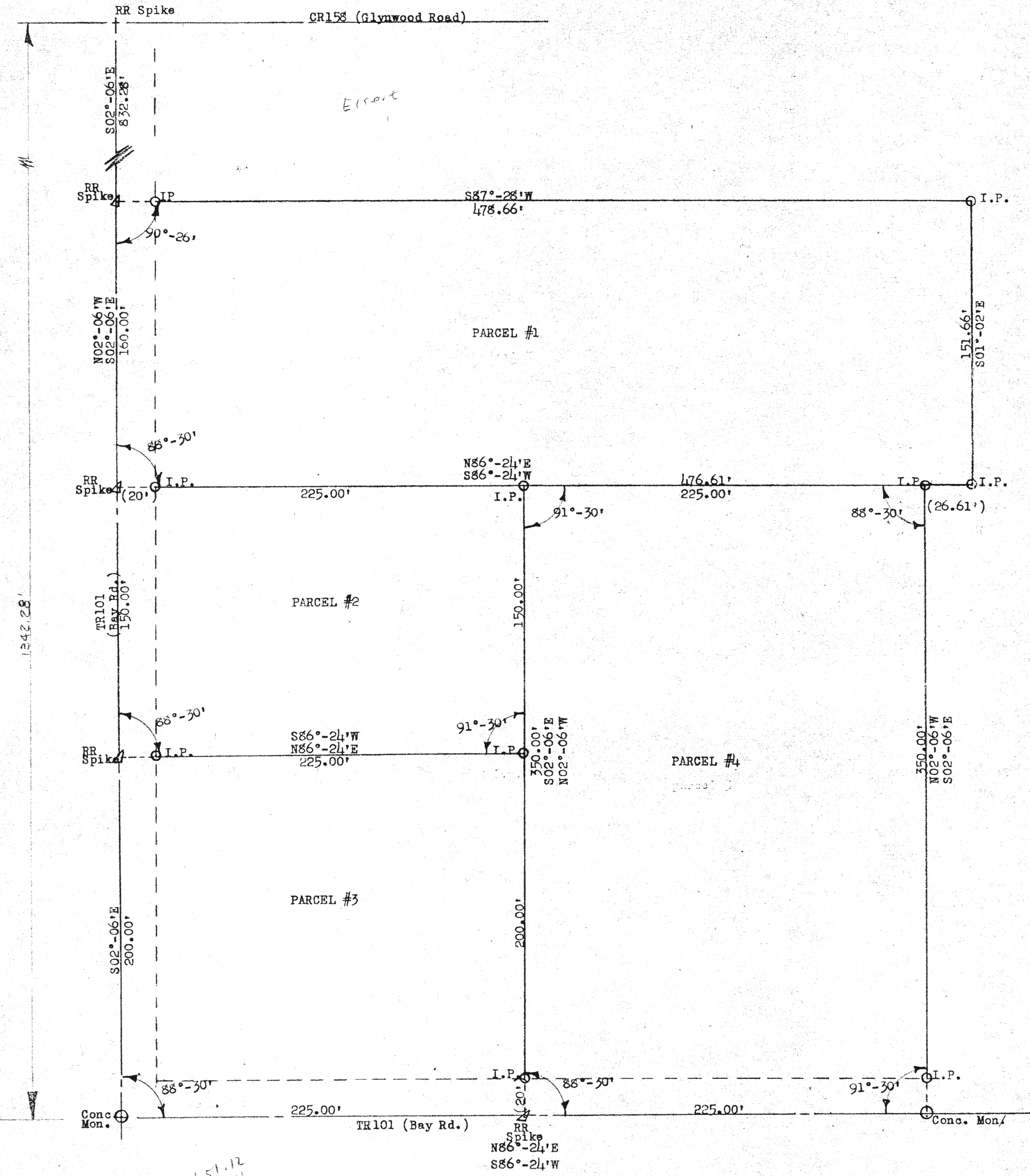




SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE
for
FERD SCHEBLO'S PARCEL NO. 1

The following tract of land is part of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section No. 27, Moulton Township, Tier 5 South, Range 5 East with respect to the First Principal Meridian, Auglaize County, Ohio, and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a railroad spike driven into the intersection of County Road No. 158 (CR158, formerly known as the Glywood Road) and Moulton Township Road No. 101 (TR101, formerly known as the Bay Road) at the approximate southwest corner of the northwest quarter of Section 27;
thence S02°-06'E along the centerline of TR101 a distance of 832.28 feet to a railroad spike which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING;
thence continuing S02°-06'E along the centerline of TR101 a distance of 160.00 feet to a railroad spike;
thence N86°-24'E through an iron pin in the twenty (20) feet right of way line and continuing for an overall distance of 476.61 feet to an iron pin;
thence N01°-02'W a distance of 151.66 feet to an iron pin;
thence S87°-28'W a distance of 478.66 feet to the railroad spike which was the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

The above tract contains 1.71 acres which is subject to 0.075 acre dedicated to the use of the public for highway purposes.

PARCEL NO. 2

The following tract of land is part of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section No. 27, Moulton Township, Tier 5 South, Range 5 East with respect to the First Principal Meridian, Auglaize County, Ohio, and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a railroad spike driven into the intersection of County Road No. 158 (CR158, formerly known as the Glynwood Road) and Moulton Township Road No. 101 (TR101, formerly known as Bay Road) at the approximate southwest corner of the northwest quarter of Section 27;
thence S02°-06'E along the centerline of TR101 a distance of 992.28 feet to a railroad spike which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING;
thence continuing S02°-06'E along the centerline of TR101 a distance of 150.00 feet to a railroad spike;
thence N86°-24'E through an iron pin at the twenty (20) feet right-of-way line and continuing an overall distance of 225.00 feet to an iron pin;
thence N02°-06'W a distance of 150.00 feet to an iron pin;
thence S86°-24'W a distance of 225.00 feet to the railroad spike which was the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

The above tract contains 0.775 acre which is subject to 0.069 acre dedicated to the use of the public for highway purposes.

PARCEL NO. 3

The following tract of land is part of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 27, Moulton Township, Tier 5 South, Range 5 East with respect to the First Principal Meridian, Auglaize County, Ohio, and is more particularly described as follows:

The PLACE OF BEGINNING is a concrete monument buried at the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of Section 27, said monument being 1342.28 feet S02°-06'E from a railroad spike driven into the intersection of County Road No. 158 (GR158, formerly the Glynwood Road) and Moulton Township Road No. 101 (TR101, formerly the Bay Road); thence N86°-24'E along the east-west portion of the centerline of TR101 (the same being the east-west half section line) a distance of 225.00 feet to a railroad spike; thence N02°-06'W through an iron pin in the twenty (20) feet right-of-way line and continuing an overall distance of 200.00 feet to an iron pin; thence S86°-24'W a distance of 225.00 feet to a railroad spike in the centerline of TR101; thence S02°06'E along the centerline of TR101 a distance of 200.00 feet to the railroad spike which was the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

The above tract contains 1.033 acre which is subject to 0.186 acre which has been dedicated for highway purposes.

PARCEL NO. 4

The following tract of land is part of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 27, Moulton Township, Tier 5 South, Range 5 East with respect to the First Principal Meridian, Auglaize County, Ohio, and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a concrete monument buried at the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of Section 27, said monument being 1342.28 feet S02°-06'E from a railroad spike driven into the intersection of County Road No. 158 (CR158, formerly the Glynwood Road) and Moulton Township Road No. 101 (TR101, formerly Bay Road);
thence N86°-24'E along the centerline of the east-west portion of TR101 (the same being the east-west half section line) a distance of 225.00 feet to a railroad spike which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING;
thence continuing N86°-24'E a distance of 225.00 feet to a concrete monument;
thence N02°-06'W through an iron pin set in the twenty (20) right-of-way line and continuing an overall distance of 350.00 feet to an iron pin;
thence S86°-24'W a distance of 225.00 feet to an iron pin;
thence S02°-06'E a distance of 350.00 feet to the railroad spike which was the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

The above tract contains 1.808 acres which is subject to 0.103 acre which has been dedicated for highway purposes.
