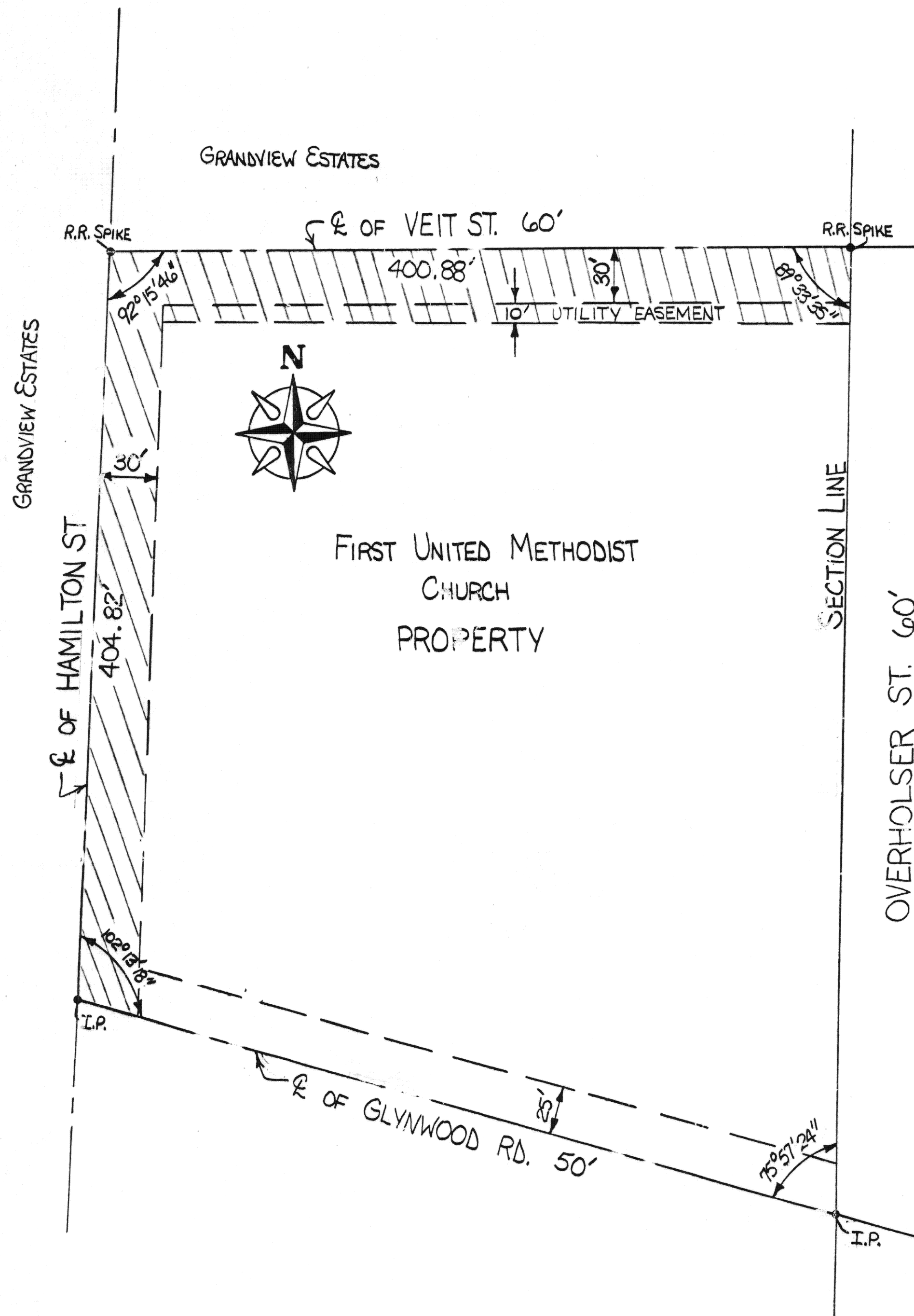


DEDICATOR'S PLAT
